Wednesday 26th September is designated as "Operation Shake-out" which is a simulated earthquake drill for the Hawkes Bay area. The "earthquake" is timed for 09.26 am. There is no official AREC involvement, but it does bring up a point or two. Are you ready, as an individual amateur, to do what you can in such an emergency ?

These days Civil Defence, i.e. local Councils, have decided that they will be self-sufficient in emergency communications, and that amateurs don't fit in with their plans. Well, that's fine, but it doesn't stop us as an amateur from being ready to assist if called upon. And we will be, as recent civil emergencies around the world have shown.

Radio is seen in some quarters as archaic, "yesterdays technology". Well maybe it has been around for a while, but when everything else fails, i.e. the internet is down because there is no AC power to the exchange, wireless internet stops working because the cell site batteries are flat, guess what will still work, and has been proven to work under all sorts of adverse conditions.

That's right ,good old -fashioned radio, either VHF or HF, and we are the people with the radios. What can you do as an individual? It doesn't take much, for instance have you got a portable HF dipole? A 12 v DC power lead with alligator clips for youir HF and VHF radios? a portable magmount or similar VHF antenna? Spare battery pack for your hand held, preferably one that takes dry cells?

Regular drills are not necessary, we do it all the time anyway. Local Branch HF nets, car rallies, field days, contests, etc. give us plenty of practice.
