**GRAVE BURIAL**

Graves may be used for the burial of one (1) person only. Burial of multiple persons is prohibited.

**MEMORIALS AND MARKERS**

Memorials and markers must be placed on the grave site. They must be made of stone or granite and must be set on a concrete base.

**PLANTINGS**

Plants, shrubs, and flowers may be placed on the grave site. They must be placed in a container and must be removed when they are no longer in bloom.
