The present membership of the choir is 200, among whom are 1 sixth-year, 2 fifth-year and 19 fourth-year members.

At this year's Annual Meeting, it was decided to have a purely choral concert and without the usual guest and other artists. This decision follows the wishes of the majority of our supporters, who have, again and again, expressed the wish that the whole programme should be supplied by the children themselves.

This year the voices have been specially picked and patrons may look forward to a good evening's entertainment.

It is with regret that, due to illness, Mr W. S. Eastwood was unable to conduct the choir this year. We acknowledge the debt we owe to him for his past enthusiastic services and express the wish that he will, ere long, be with us again.

Miss K. Coles, deputy-conductor, has filled the breach created by Mr. Eastwood's withdrawal and to her we acknowledge a deep debt of gratitude. She has entered upon her duties with splendid enthusiasm and under her inspiring leadership, the choir has made rapid progress.

The number of Associate Members remains at approximately 100 and to them we accord our sincere thanks for their interest in the choir's activities and for their financial assistance. We hope that in the coming session their numbers will be substantially increased. Thus will the cultural life of our community be substantially strengthened by the continued sympathy and co-operation of our Associate Members with the work of the Choir.
