The Committee of the Hastings Primary Schools' Choir has pleasure in presenting to the public its eighth Annual Concert.

As happens every year, we lose a large number of senior choir members to the post primary schools. It is our hope that these children who have acquired a love of music in this Schools' Choir, at an age when the habits of a lifetime are formed, will seek anew, in adult life, the satisfaction they found in the organisation which they have outgrown.

This year we take pleasure in welcoming 80 new members, many of whom are only nine years of age. The present membership of the choir is 160, among whom are one sixth year, two fifth year, and 11 fourth year members.

It is nearly ten years since the idea of a Hastings Primary Schools' Choir was conceived. In 1946 as a result of generous public subscription we received our first class piano. To-day we claim that the choir has become a permanent institution in our community life. Moreover, the Annual Concert would appear to be coming more akin to a Musical Festival.

It is with a deal of pleasure that we record that this year the Choir affiliated with the newly formed Hastings Music and Drama Council. We are happy to lend countenance to their worthy proposals for the advancement of community life generally and at the same time preserve our own identity.

Miss K. Coles, Conductor, has again entered upon her duties with splendid enthusiasm and under her inspiring leadership, the choir has made rapid progress.

The number of Associate Members is 84 and to them we accord our sincere thanks for their interest in the choir's activities and for their financial assistance.

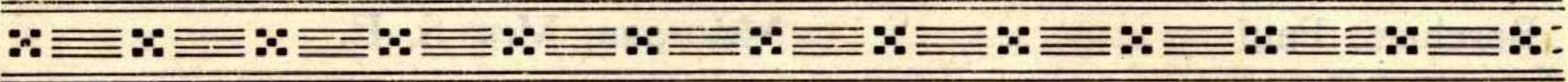

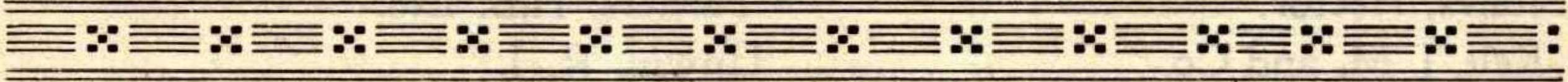
