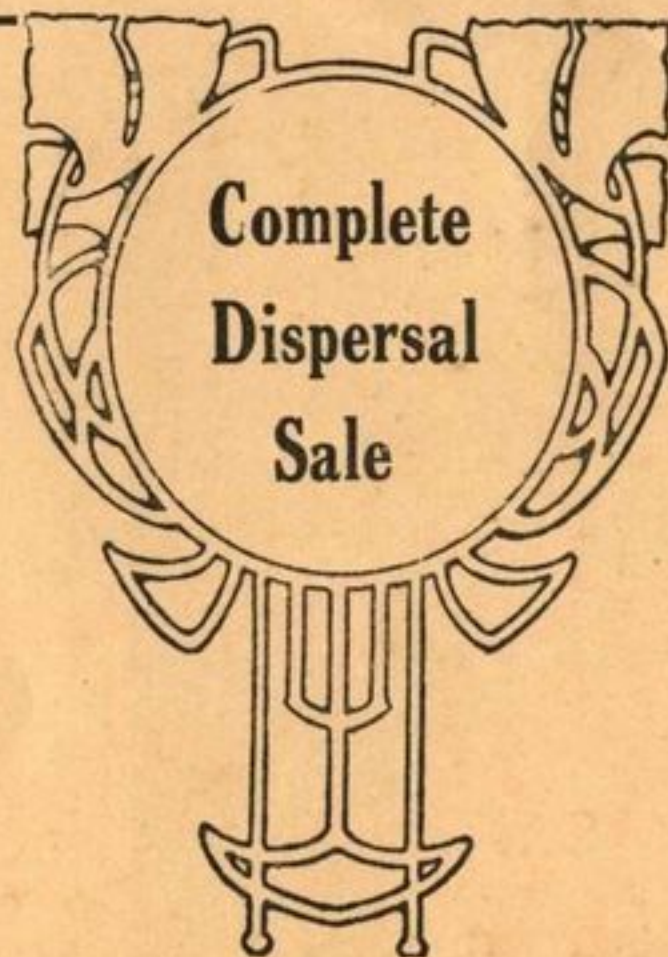

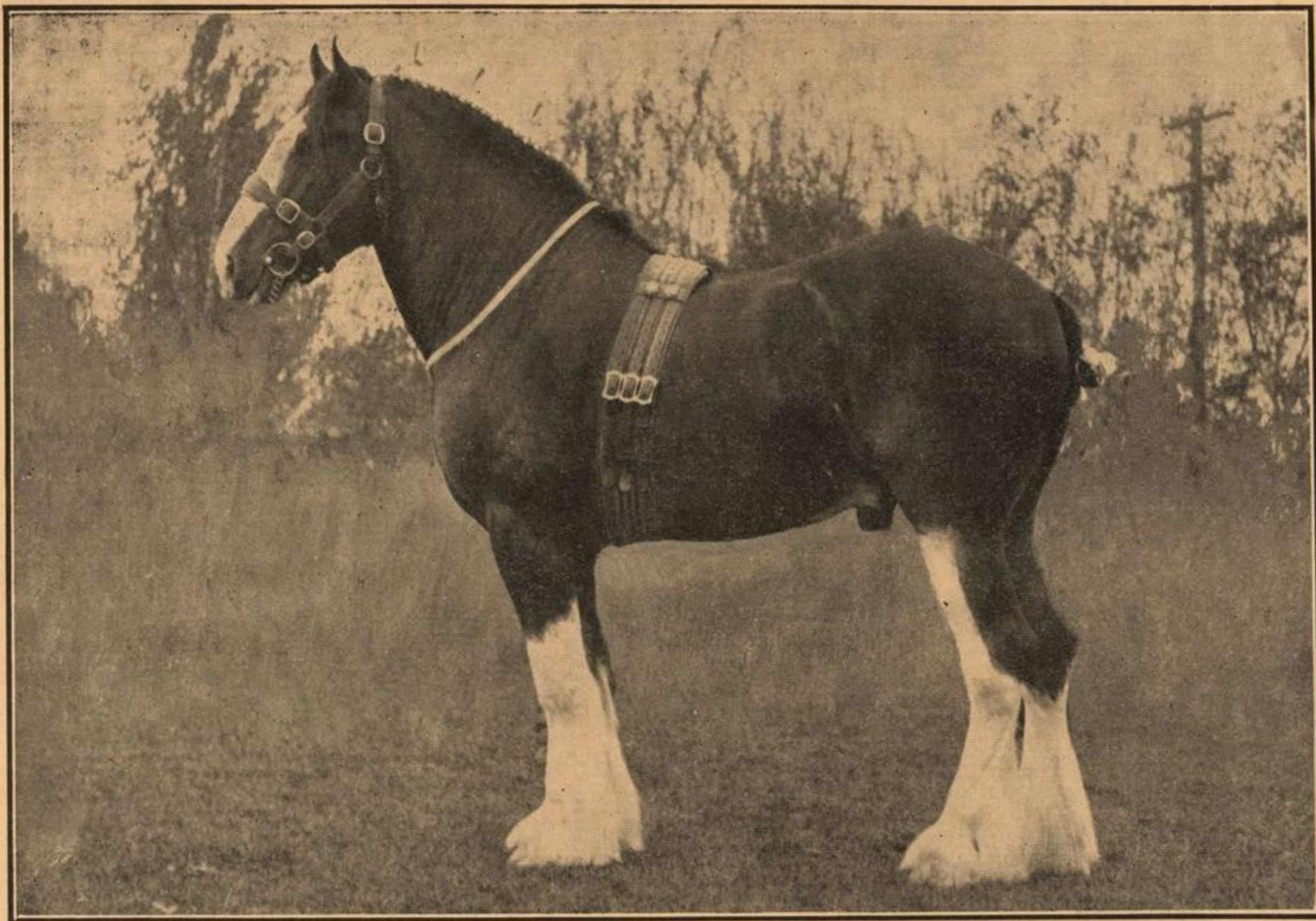

INTRODUCTION.

ON account of the death of Sir R. D. D. McLean the Trustees of Maraekakaho Station have decided to disperse the whole of the **Maraekakaho Stud of Clydesdale Horses** by Public Auction. Founded in the later seventies, the Maraekakaho Clydesdale Stud has been prominent for generations past. To-day it ranks among the foremost in Australasia, both in size and importance, Maraekakaho being indeed a household word in Clydesdale circles. From time to time many valuable importations were made by the late Sir R. D. D. McLean, the founder of this historic Stud, some of the greatest blood extant in Great Britain finding its way to Maraekakaho.

In point of the foregoing it is interesting to recall what that eminent overseas livestock journal, "The Scottish Farmer," had to say some 15 years ago touching the importation by Sir Douglas of the mare **Maid o' Threave** and the stallion **Junior Chief**, the latter being still at the head of the Maraekakaho Stud: "One of Mr. McLean's purchases," says the journal in question, "is the well-bred colt **Junior Chief (17,688)**, by the celebrated Cawdor Cup champion Bonnie Buchlyvie, out of a mare by the 1000-guineas horse Silver Cup (11,184), which was three times first at the H. and A.S. Shows and twice first at the Royal. Junior Chief's great granddam is the famous prize mare Jeannie Darnley (8608), one of the best of the many first-class daughters of Darnley (222). There are not many better bred colts than this, and with him Mr McLean should maintain the tradition established by his father [it was Sir Douglas himself] when he purchased the fine horse Berlin Congress (1061) at the H. and A. S., Dumfries, in 1878, where that horse was fourth in a great class of big, weighty carthorses. Along with Junior Chief, Mr. McLean ships to New Zealand the famous mare Maid of Threave

(34,601), foaled in 1908, and got by the H. and A. S. champion horse Benedict (10,315), out of the well-bred mare Jenny Weir, by the beautiful horse Woodend Gartly (10,663), which was first at Ayr when a three-year-old and was champion across the Atlantic. Maid o' Threave is one of the best and weightiest mares seen in a Scots show-yard in recent years. As a yearling in the hands of Mr. H. B. Marshall, of Rachan, she was fifth at Kilmarnock, third at the Royal Gloucester, and third at the H. and A. S., Stirling; as a two-year-old she was second at Ayr; and as a three-year-old third at Kilmarnock, second at Ayr, and second at Edinburgh. She was sold at the Rachan Stud dispersion at Lanark in October, 1912, at a high price to Mr. Brydon, and this year, in his hands she won numerous prizes both in the North of England, and at the principal shows in Scotland. In shape and quality, with weight and substance combined, she was always regarded as one of the best show mares of her time, and she is the sort New Zealand is always glad to have."

Among the descendants of this celebrated mare, **Maid o' Threave**, to be found in this Catalogue, are four full-sisters, sired by **Junior Chief**, who is still at the head of the Maraekakaho Stud, and is himself catalogued. Junior Chief has long since made a name for himself as a sire of some of the greatest prize-winning stock in the land, his progeny having won innumerable high awards, including many championships.

Another sire which stood the Maraekakaho Stud in great stead was the imported horse, **Berlin Congress (1061)**, bred by Mr. Ralston, of Stranraer, Scotland, and this horse was got by the famous **Lord Lyon (489)**. Sir Douglas McLean also imported an outstanding mare named **Loch Leven**, a bay daughter of the great **Lothian Lad** from a Lord Clyde mare. Various additions have been made as time went on of mares from the foremost breeders in New Zealand, and amongst others several imported stallions

have been used, including **Clydebank (170)** and **Pride of Newton (12,280)**, both of whom have left their imprint on the pages of New Zealand Clydesdale history.

Present-day sires at Maraekakaho include **High Mark** (imp. in utero), by Lothian Pride, out of Ruby of Smerby (imp.). High Mark spent his earlier years in the South Island, where he gained many high awards and left stock which have done well both at the stud and in the show ring. One of his sons at Maraekakaho, in **High Tide**, was first at Hastings in 1928 and first at the Manawatu Royal in 1928, as a yearling in each case, and one of his daughters in **Maraekakaho Lady Markham** has won successively at Hastings as a yearling, two-year-old and three-year-old.

Another sire in use at the present time is **Maraekakaho Bonnie Lad** and this young horse is fast making a name for himself as an excellent breeding horse. Bonnie Lad himself was first and champion on two occasions at Hastings. He is a beautifully-bred horse and for some time past has been bred to the Junior Chief mares. Thus the Maraekakaho Stud has been line-breeding to **Bonnie Buchlyvie**, the sire of Junior Chief. Bonnie Lad is by Bonnie Dene, and the latter horse is by Bonnie Buchlyvie. Junior Chief is also by Bonnie Buchlyvie, who, of course, is of very distinguished lineage, being by Baron of Buchlyvie, by Baron's Pride. Quite a number of the younger horses catalogued have been line-bred, as indicated above.

The complete Stud of Maraekakaho Clydesdales is to be dispersed, and in view of the Stud's paramount importance and unrivalled supremacy, the Sale can safely be recommended to breeders throughout New Zealand and Australia.

The Sale will take place at the Valley Farm, Maraekakaho Station, a few miles in from Hastings, Hawke's Bay, N.Z., on **TUESDAY, OCTOBER 15th, 1929, at 9.30 a.m.**

SELDOM does the opportunity occur of acquiring a stallion of the calibre of JUNIOR CHIEF. Imported by the late Sir R. D. D. McLean some 15 years ago from Robert Brydon, of the noted Seaham Harbour stud, England, Junior Chief was indeed bred in the purple, being sired by the celebrated Cawdor Cup champion, Bonnie Bucklyvie (by Baron of Bucklyvie, by Baron's Pride), out of a mare by the 1000-guinea horse Silver Cup (11,184), which was three times first at the H. and A. S. shows and twice first at the Royal. Junior Chief's great granddam is the famous prize mare, Jeannie Darnley (8608*), one of the best of the many first-class daughters of the great Darnley (222). Junior Chief was 20 months old when he came to New Zealand, and was shown only once, viz., at 7-years-old, when he was 1st and champion at the Hawke's Bay Show, Hastings. Sir Douglas only brought him out on the one occasion, as he generously held that it would only discourage local breeders if their entries were pitted against an imported horse of such outstanding merit. The progeny of Junior Chief have inherited many of their distinguished sire's best characteristics, having swept the boards at leading shows in the Dominion on numerous occasions. The long list of champions he has sired include: Maraekakaho Salisbury Lass, champion mare, Hawke's Bay; Maraekakaho Lady Meikle, champion mare, Hawke's Bay; Maraekakaho Lady Jane, winner of the 2-year-old class at the Canterbury Royal Show, 1925; Maraekakaho May Queen, first at Hawke's Bay, and first at Manawatu Show as a yearling; and others too numerous to mention. Then again, Lord Fernhill, a son of Junior Chief, was first at Hawke's Bay in 1927, as a 3-year-old colt.

Junior Chief is a splendid tempered horse, with a perfect manner and disposition. He is a sure foal-getter and is still capable of siring many more valuable colts. He has never been overdone or knocked about. Practically all the prize-winning stock from Maraekakaho during the last 12 years have been sired by Junior Chief.

HIGH MARK (imp.) is the veteran sire of the stud, and he has undoubtedly left his imprimatur on the Maraekakaho Clydesdales. This is only to be expected of a horse of his peerless breeding. He was bred in Argyllshire by Andrew Stewart of Smerby fame, Cambeltown, being by Lothian Pride (imp.) from Ruby of Smerby, both names to conjure with in their day, and they are to be found to-day behind many of the breed's best. High Mark is to-day over 20 years of age, and he was acquired by "The Laird of Maraekakaho" some five years ago. In his earlier years he was shown freely in the South Island, where he won many high awards, and sired stock which have done exceedingly well both as breeders and prize-getters. One of his sons, High Tide (who is himself catalogued for sale at Maraekakaho), was 1st at Hawke's Bay in 1928, and 1st at the Manawatu Royal 1928—as a yearling in each case. Maraekakaho Lady Markham, a daughter of High Mark, was first at Hawke's Bay Show as a yearling, and first there, too, as a 2-year-old, and she won again at Hawke's Bay as a 3-year-old, and was second at Manawatu three years ago. That is all the stock by him shown by Maraekakaho. Although he is now, naturally showing signs of age, High Mark is still a good server and foal-getter.

His sire—the imported horse Bonnie Dene—has had a very successful career in the Moore-Hunter Stud, and has left a large number of championship winners. Bessie Salisbury, the dam of Bonnie Lad, goes back to Lord Salisbury, a great horse in his day. Bonnie Lad was 1st and champion on two occasions at Hawke's Bay, and was second at the Manawatu Royal in 1924. He is an absolutely sound horse, and a sure foal getter. He is also blessed with a splendid disposition. Furthermore he is a good breeder, and his progeny are rich in promise and should do exceedingly well in the show ring.

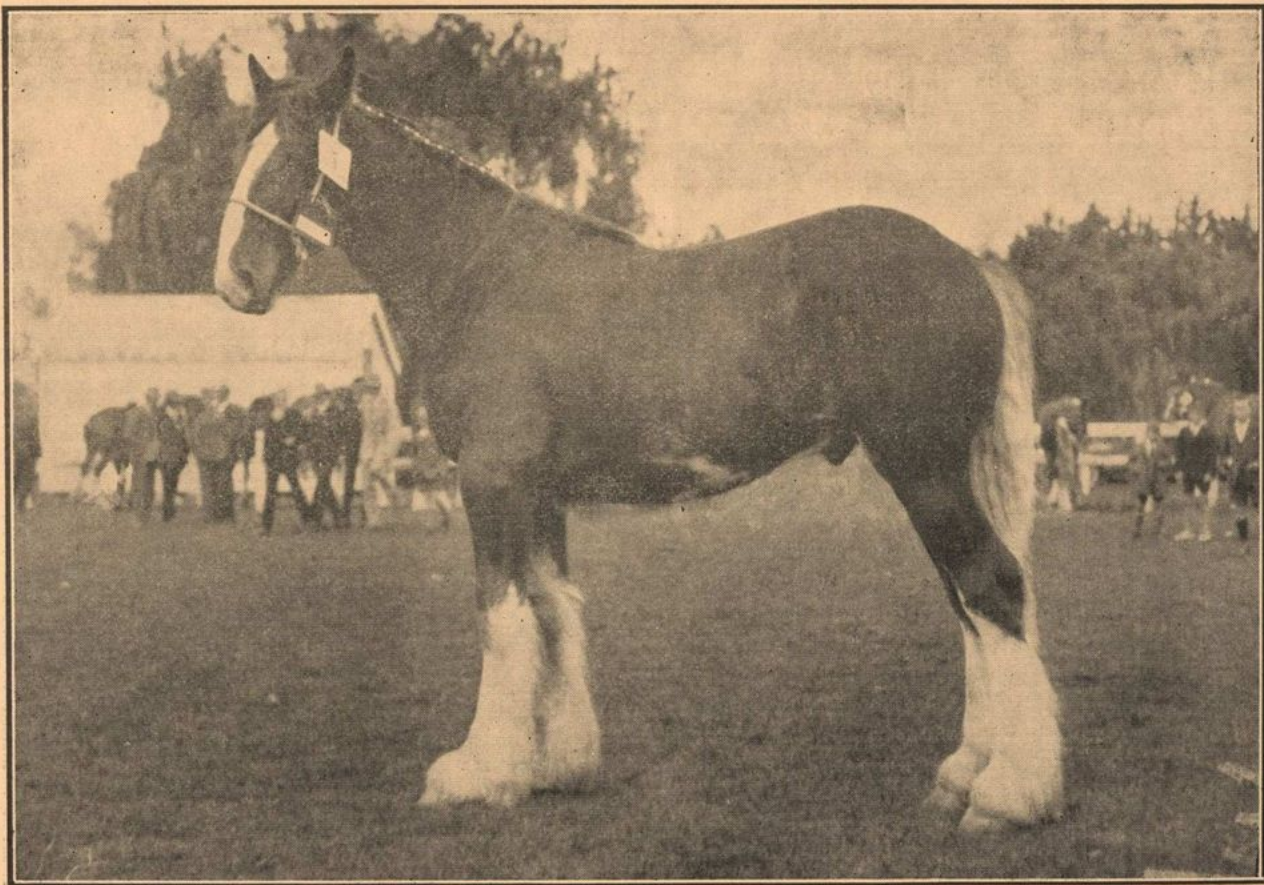

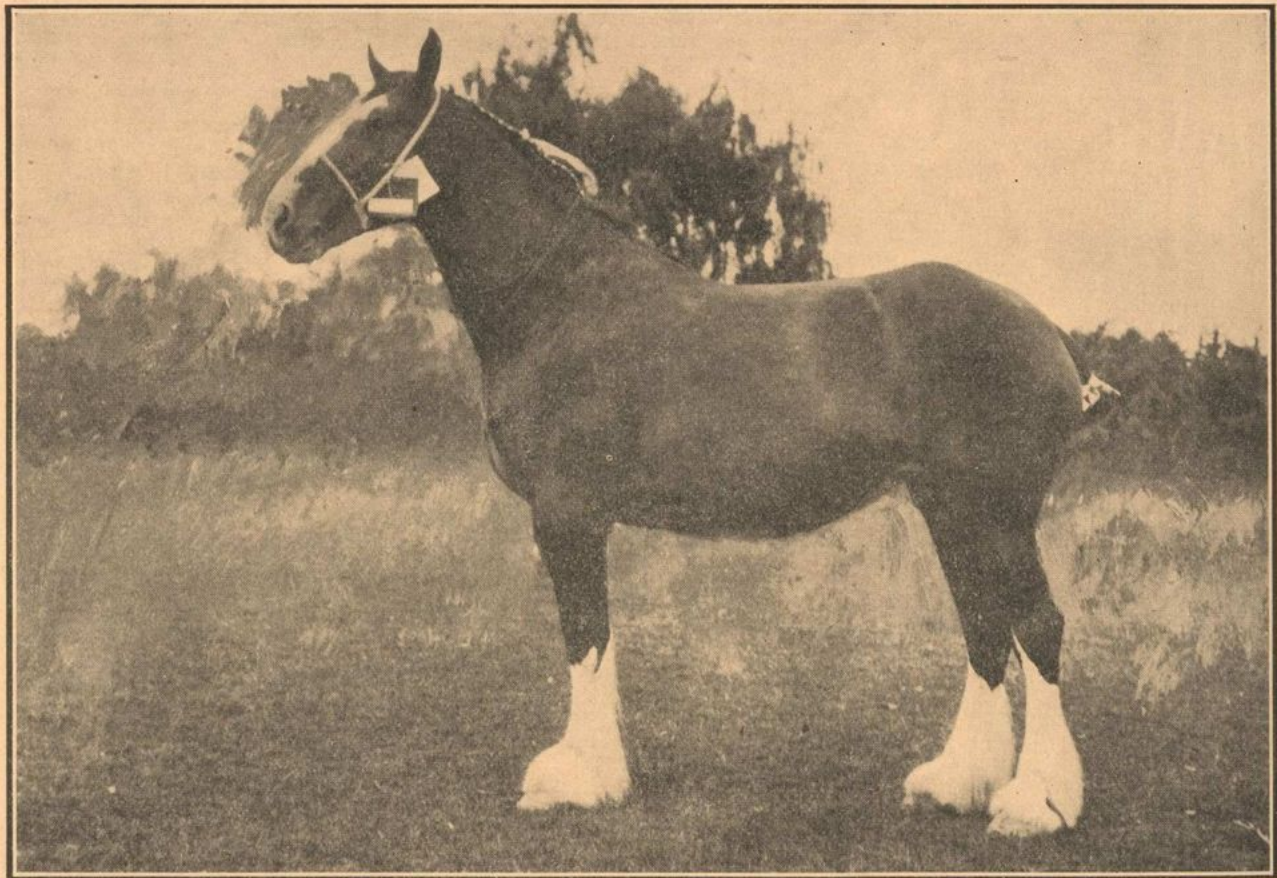

MARAEKAKAHO LADY JANE is one of four full-sisters, and seldom does one catalogue contain a quartette of such classical breeding. Mares of their stamp are not bred every day in the week, and even with the foot-and-mouth embargo removed it would be difficult to import four Clydesdales with a "family tree" so handsomely endowed. The other full-sisters are Bonnie Maid (see Lot 27), Maraekakaho Lady Meikle (see Lot 18), and a 5-year-old mare which through inadvertence was not registered. The four full-sisters are by the imported stallion Junior Chief, out of the famous mare, Maid o' Threave, imported by Sir Douglas McLean many years ago. 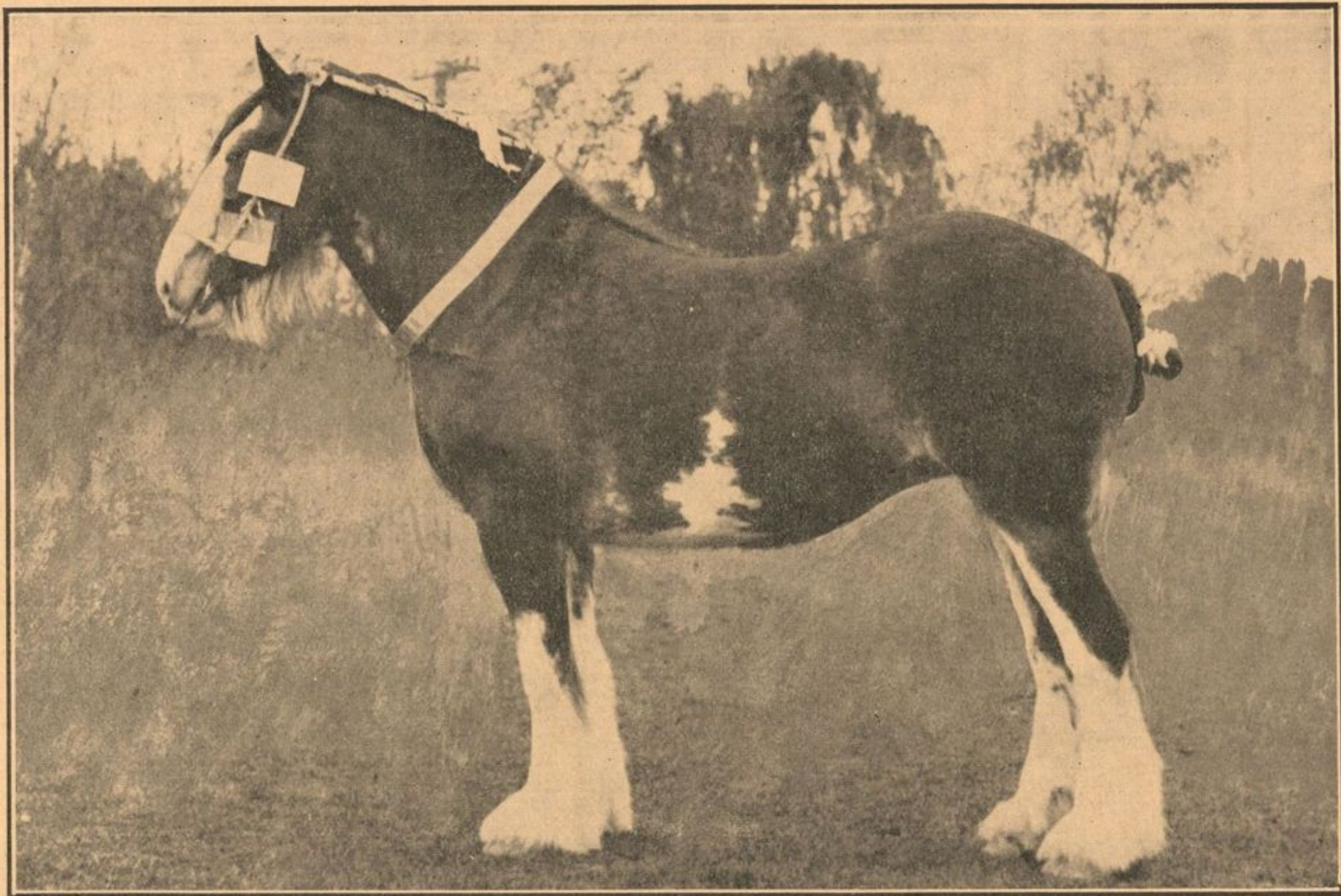
