of your merits to confer on you a suitable Title of Promotion do create you a Public Notary previous Examination  
and the other requisites to be herein observed having been had and so out of our favour towards you admit you into  
the number and society of other Notaries to the end that you may transact business at Capetown abroad and also in all other  
other Provinces Foreign Territories Colonies and Dominions and not in any other place whatsoever exercise the Office of a  
Notary hereby bearing full faith ought to be given as well in Judgment as to the documents to be made  
by you after the Oath and Declaration hereunder written shall have been required of you and by you duly taken and  
subscribed.

I. Francis Logan do swear that I will be faithful and bear true Allegiance to Her Majesty Queen Victoria  
Her heirs and Successors according to Law.  
To help me God.

II. Francis Logan do solemnly swear and truly declare and affirm that I will faithfully exercise the Office of a  
Public Notary & will faithfully make Contracts or Instruments for or between any Party or Parties requiring the same  
and I will not add or diminish any thing without the Knowledge and Consent of such Party or Parties that may alter  
the substance of the same I will not make or attest any Act Contract or Instrument in writing I shall know there is in  
Violence or Fraud and in all things I will act uprightly and justly in the business of a Public Notary according to the  
best of my Skill and Ability.

III. Francis Logan do solemnly swear and truly declare and affirm that I am committed at Capetown in the  
Provincial District of Simon's Bay in the Colony of New Zealand and am desirous of being created a Public Notary  
for the purpose of acting as such at Capetown abroad and also in all other Provinces Foreign Territories Colonies  
and Dominions and not in any other place whatsoever.

Provided always that these presents do not avail you anything until the Oath and Declaration upon the  
Commission bearing date the twentyfourth day of February in the year of our Lord  
One thousand eight hundred and eighty three as above prescribed be subscribed and duly taken by you in  
pursuant to the tenor of the said Commission and the Certificate endorsed on these presents as to the execution  
of the said Commission be subscribed by the proper Officer before whom the said Oath and Declaration shall  
be taken and sealed with his Official Seal and also unless these presents are duly registered and subscribed by  
the Secretary of Procurator of the Ordinariate Ecclesiastical of Great Britain (O.W.M.) under the seal of the  
Office of Procurator at Doctors Common the twentyfourth day of February in the year of our Lord One  
thousand eight hundred and eighty three.
