







**SNOOKER**

THE RULES OF THE GAME

1. The game is played on a rectangular table covered with green cloth, with a white line around the edge. The table is divided into three sections by two parallel lines, called the baulk lines. The balls are placed on the table as follows: the white ball is in the center, the red balls are in the baulk area, and the other balls are in the other two sections.

2. The player whose turn it is to play must first hit the white ball with the cue. The white ball must then hit one of the red balls, which must then hit the baulk line. This is called a 'pot'.

3. If a red ball is potted, the player who potted it has the right to continue to play. If a red ball is not potted, the cue ball must be re-spotted in the center of the table.

4. If a white ball is potted, the cue ball must be re-spotted in the center of the table.

5. If a ball is potted in a pocket, it is removed from the table.

6. The game ends when all the red balls have been potted. The player who has potted the most balls wins the game.
