SARex 2016

This year's search and rescue exercise was held last weekend (19/20 November). We have worked in this area before and, weather wise, we had more of the same. Winds gusting up to 140Km/h meant it was tiring just being outside. The camper van and caravan were bouncing around a fair bit and deprived the inhabitants of much sleep. There was little rain but what did come at us from 10 or so kilometres away was horizontal. One side of my vehicle was wet and the other dry. We lost the night frequency antenna with the cost of one split section on the fibreglass mast. This has been organised for repair.

Aside from all that the exercise was a success. The efficiency of the search teams meant the lost parties were found quickly, the last one ten minutes after the 1900 sched on Saturday night, and all teams spent the night out and headed for base in the morning. This allowed for everyone to be able to get homeward bound well before lunch time.
