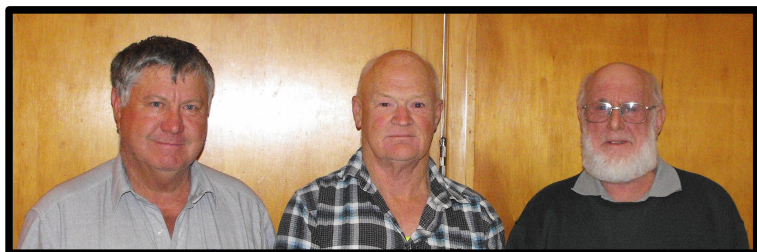
We may have a 5 min. meeting at the beginning for any urgent business otherwise it will be a recreational night and business carried over to our July meeting.

Seapac Convention

Seapac, Northwestern Division Convention was held in Seaside Oregon May 31 and June 1 and 2 this year. The convention was co sponsored by the Oregon Tualatin Valley Amateur Radio Club and the Clark County Amateur Radio Club. There were over 2100 Hams registered for the event.

After my trip to Norfolk Island last October my companions, all from Portland Oregon and members of the Oregon Tualatin Valley Amateur Radio Club, invited me to attend this Convention as their guest. We were the guest speakers at the DX Luncheon.

It is the first of this type of event I have ever attended. Arriving in Seaside on Friday midday there was not a lot going on until the evening when several portable stations were set up on the beach. Not a lot of contacts were evident; most of the equipment was QRP. Several antenna types were being used including kites.

On Saturday the Exhibitor and Flea market were opened and imagine 2000 odd hams trying to get in all at once. The fleamarket seemed to have the usual collection of junk and some desirable items. The area taken was about 6 times the area of the Pakowhai hall. Due to renovations at the Convention Centre this area was restricted so who knows what didn't make it to the tables. There were 30 + exhibitors in attendance, the likes of HRO and numerous antenna and equipment sellers. There was a great selection of things to spend money on but I resisted. If you ever get the chance to visit a Hamvention I would say go.

If you have a large number of vendors attending your table please attach a list of their names and callsigns, if applicable, to your registration form. If you would like us to keep your vendor passes for collection on the day please indicate on the registration form.

Boot, trailer sales and other special bookings will again be available please contact the organiser with details to negotiate costs. **They will however not be under cover**

Some wheeled trolleys etc will be available in order to unload your items prior to the sale. Remember it is your responsibility to remove your unsold items. A charge will be made for the disposal of any unsold items left in the hall after the sale. **Note that mains power is not available for the tables**
