

years to come with work currently focused on building a panel shop.





The history of Nimon and Sons 1905 to 2011

Giles Nimon, or Jack as he was commonly known, bought the company from William Arthur Beeroft. Jack was a bullock driver who worked for the Donnelly family driving wagons loaded with wool from inland Pates to Napier port. He met his future wife, Edith née Ridd, a seamstress who also worked for the Donnelly family about this time. Jack and Edith's surviving children were John Joseph generally known as Joe, William Arthur, Edward Cecil, Edith and the youngest, Richard Alexander. In 1895 Jack worked for William Beeroft a livery stable owner operating in Havelock and Hastings, William

1910

With the invention of the motor vehicle the company expanded and bought a Studebaker eight-seater bus, which was later converted to a 10-seater. An old photograph survives from 1916 which shows the vehicle transporting girls from lona College on a school outing. Bill and Joe went overseas to fight in WM1 and Edith, her daughter and the two youngest boys helped with the business. Their father died in 1914. At the end of the war Bill and Joe came home to run the family business.

1923

Motor buses were added to the fleet in 1910 and in 1923 the first full sized bus, a Thornycroft with pneumatic tyres,

believed to be a first for the district, and possibly New Zealand, was purchased.

Edith lived until 1955, surviving her son Bill who died of a heart attack while doing war work at Napier Wharf in 1943.

1926

The company bought a Studebaker, the first vehicle with dual pneumatic tyres.

1963

Joe's son, John Rodney Nimon took over as Managing Director.

1967

The bus fleet grew to 11 buses. John had also started a refrigerated trucking company called Road Air in 1956.

Practical, sustainable and good looking design

LHT Design Managing Director Alan Thompson praised Bill Nimon for his vision and desire to plan for the future while incorporating good design and environmentally sustainable development into Nimon's new transport hub. Bill was able to see the value of doing things well and LHT Design followed through with his vision, Alan said. The workshop is aesthetically pleasing and practical at the same time, and has been designed to cater for buses and trucks for many years to come. Bill also wanted to create an energy efficient and environmentally sustainable depot that offered comfortable working conditions far better than the industry norm. LHT Design was involved at the outset helping identify and evaluate the Whakatu site as the ideal place to build a transport hub. It was a challenging site as the

ground was quite soft so geotextile materials had to be incorporated into the basecourse design.

The project encompassed all aspects of the design process from geotechnical, civil, structural, electrical, mechanical, architectural and regulatory, Alan said. There were some new ideas and some challenging aspects such as raised inspection bays in the 1200m2 workshop, rather than inspection pits, which is a novel and thought provoking idea. Up to 10 trucks and buses can be serviced at any time.

Next door to the workshop is a data serviced, fully airconditioned administration building of some 300m2. The depot has ample parking and extensive landscaping is proposed in conjunction with Hawke's Bay Regional Council Project Manager Rob Macphail explained that rainwater collected from the roof is used for drometic supply. There's an on-site well that can be used as back up during dry periods. There's also on-site storm water drainage with a large rain garden in the middle of the property. Heating and ventilation systems are extremely energy efficient and the mechanics benefit from a ground sourced heat pump which provides under floor heating where they work.

LHT personnel monitored the construction by Gemco Construction and the end result is a good looking and highly functional depot and transport hub that meets the needs of Nimon and Sons Ltd now and for the foreseeable future.



In the late 1980s Nimon and Sons took over some school runs from Mt Cook and Newmans Coach Services.

In 1990 the company took on more Ministry of Education runs and in 1991 took over Railway Road Services in Napier and Hastings and the fleet expanded considerably.

A typical bus fleet in the 1990s consisted of 1 x B58 Volvo x Newmans, 2 x RK 176 Hinos x Cityline and 1 x NFM Bedford x Cityline.

Bill Nimon took over as Managing Director in 2003 when his father John died. The company took delivery of a new bus that "kneels" to allow easier access.

Nimon and Sons ran the Havelock North to Hastings run continuously for 104 years until 2009 when the runs were lost to tender but they picked up significant school tenders and more than doubled the number of runs.

Nimon and Sons won all the Taupo school services from February 1 and the fleet consisted of more than 98 vehicles

On 20 March 2011 the company move its operations to new depot at 39 Whakatu Road, Whakatu, Hastings. The new premises were officially opened by National MP for Tukituki Craig Foss on Saturday 6 August 2011.

A brand new bus #17 was delivered in mid-July and the drivers are currently receiving training. With dual axle steering it is quite different to drive. The new bus with a white livery will be used around town. It was made in New Zealand by Kiwi Bus in Tauranga and meets Euro-Five emission standards
