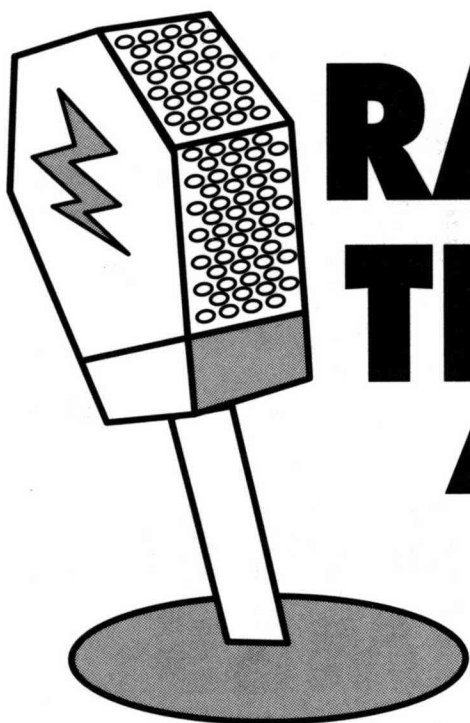

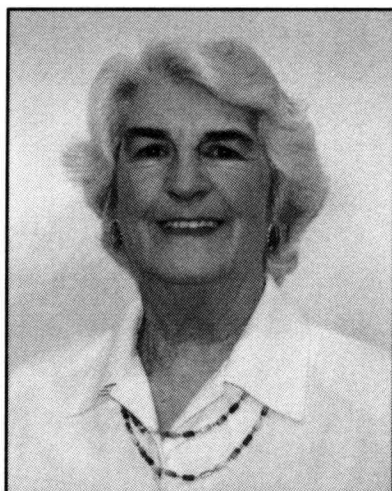


A Message from our President . . .

Welcome to this evening's performance of "Radio Times '97". The first show of our second century.

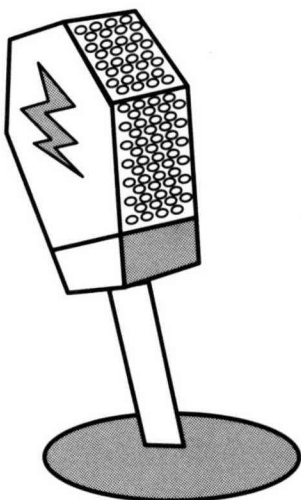

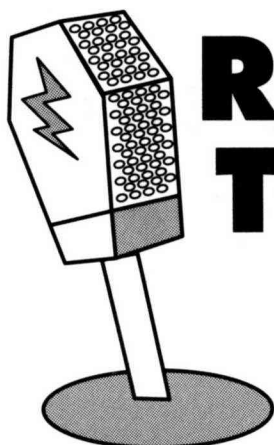
Verse: Goodnight Sweetheart, everybody sings,
