

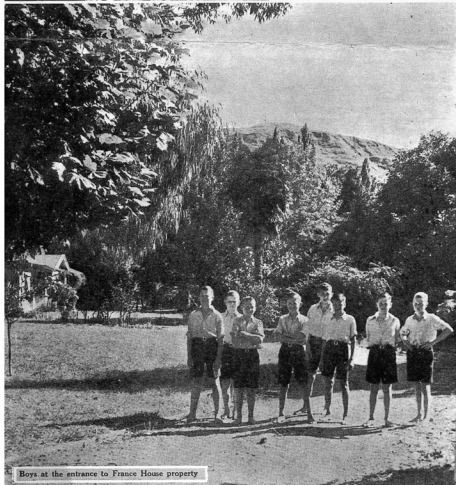

Randall House in Napier caters for children of all ages and the 27 children at present there range from 2 to 16 years. Placed high on the Napier hills and set

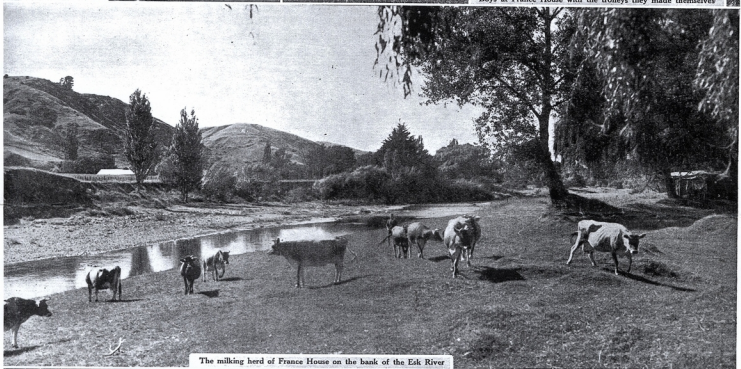

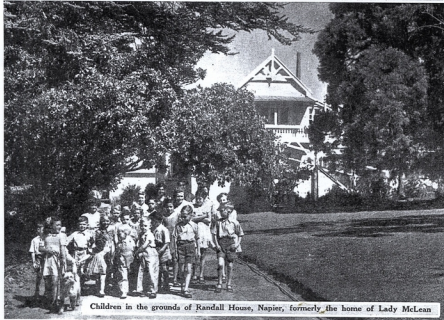
