1. Pass Conditions:

- (1) School Certificate: A candidate must obtain not less than 200 marks in the aggregate for English and his next three highest marked subjects. The minimum marks to count in any subject is 30.
- (2) School Certificate (where candidates are exempted from the provision requiring instruction in Music or Fine Art): A candidate must obtain not less than 250 marks in the aggregate for English and his next four highest marked subjects. The minimum marks to count in any subject is 30.
- (3) Certificate of Attainment: As in (2) above.
- (4) Marks shown are percentages except in Mathematics and Shorthand and Typewriting for which the maximum is 50 in each branch. In Shorthand and Typewriting a minimum of 15 marks in each branch is required.
