It may seem early to start talking of next years District 993 Conference but I do so for a reason. It is to be held in Hastings and as a Club, we will be asked to have a share in its organisation. Over recent years, attendance at a conference has never seemed a priority to our Club and I'm sure this is to our disadvantage. I must admit to feeling embarrassed for the Club when at the roll call at this year's conference in Napier, I was the sole representative. Waikato Sunrise Club (7 an meeting time) won the Membership award.

Looking forward now to next year, the Stortford Lodge Club has been asked to take the early initiatives in planning and I am keen that we are ready to play our part when asked.
