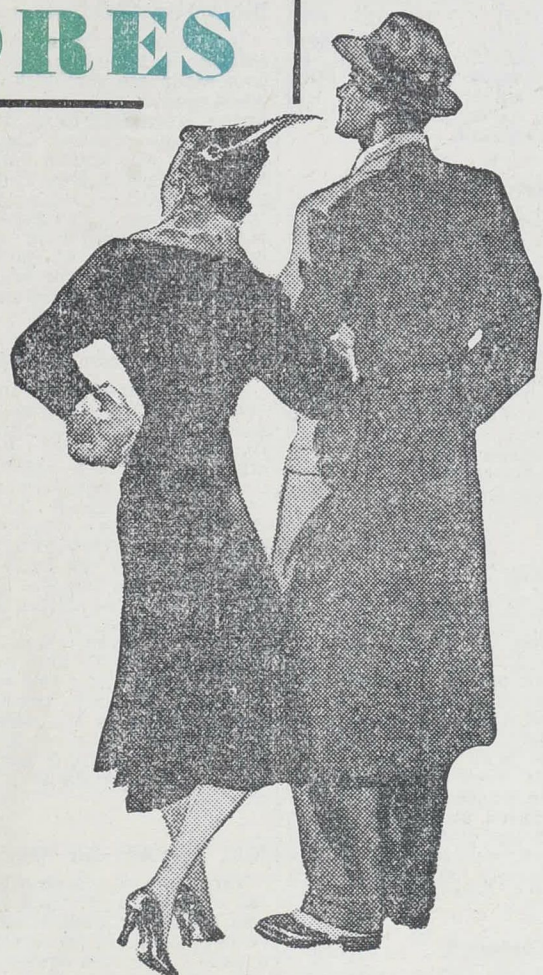

VIGOROUS REPLY TO THE PRIME MINISTER

Sir Alfred Ransom Argues The Question Of Interest Rates

DANNEVIRKE.

"The figures quoted by the Prime Minister in his address here last Saturday as to the farmers obtaining cheaper money were due to the prudent administration of the past Government," said Sir Alfred Ransom, M.P. for Pahiatua, in his address at the Town Hall last night.

"The present Government has by no means reduced the rate of interest, and I defy them to prove otherwise."

Referring to Mr Savage's speech, Sir Alfred said that it had been somewhat embarrassing to be occupying a seat on the stage with him without being able to interject, but he would now endeavour to point out the Prime Minister's mistakes.

"It is only natural to assume that the Government's huge spending campaign is responsible for the increases in taxation," Sir Alfred said, "and it is the worker who bears the heavy end of the load as a result. Yet Mr Savage stated that he and his ministers are actually helping the workers, so that they are better off to-day than before. That is absurd, as every clear-thinking man can see."

Lower Interest.
"Before the Labour Party came into power, interest charges had been reduced during the previous year by £5,800,000, and the past Government—not the present—gave the farmers cheaper money," continued Sir Alfred.

"The Coalition Government reduced the rate of interest in the State Advances Department to 4.18 per cent, and it also arranged with the banks to reduce overdraft rates to 5 per cent," Sir Alfred said. "The only interest rate reduced by the present socialistic Government was the overdraft rate at the Reserve Bank to 1 1/2 per cent. The Government looked well after its own obligations, but neglected to include the farmer and the business-man."

"100 per cent Profit"
"An offer was recently made to local bodies to obtain loans for house building at 3 1/2 per cent, but they could well afford to make the offer, since they were paying but 1 1/2 per cent, thereby making a clear profit of over 100 per cent."

In conclusion Sir Alfred reminded the people that New Zealand was too good a country to be ruined by socialism or Communism and it was up to every lover of his country to put his shoulder to the wheel in an effort to save the Dominion.
