COSTS AT MEMORIAL HOSPITAL, HASTINGS

Chairman of Board Says That Additional Beds are Much Needed

The reasons for the higher costs per occupied bed at the Memorial Hospital, Hastings, compared with other hospitals in the same class, were explained by the chairman of the Hastings Hospital Board (Mr. C. Lawson) in a special report which was dealt with at the monthly meeting of the board in Napier yesterday.

An exhaustive account of receipts and payments for the same period was given, and it was shown that the cost per occupied bed at the Memorial Hospital was 20s. 6d. as compared with 16s. 6d. for the same class of hospitals in the Dominion. It was pointed out that the average number of occupied beds was 62, as against 40 at the other hospitals.

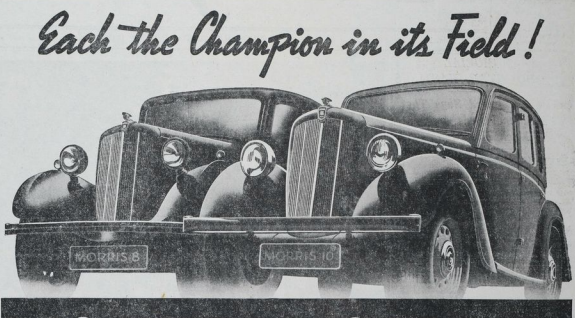

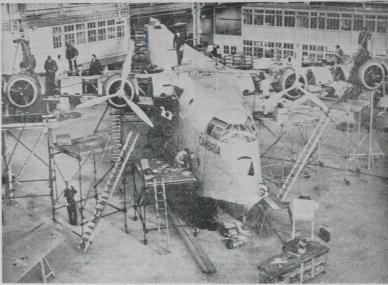

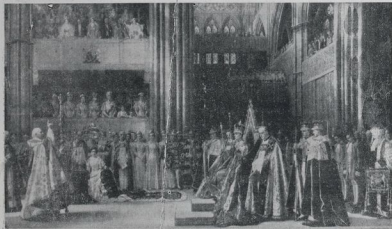
