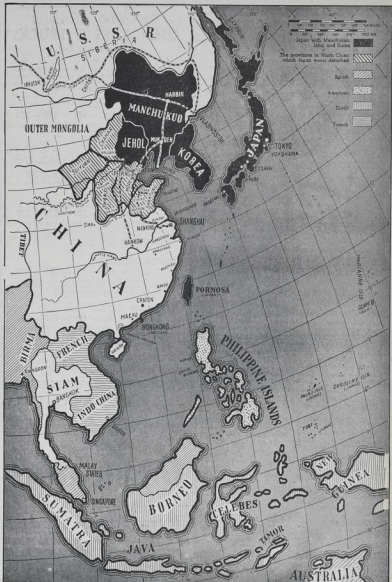

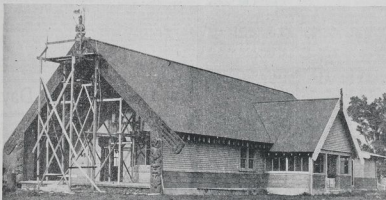

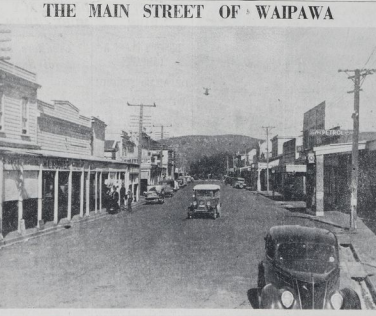

WORM CONTROL IN SHEEP

"What About Trying the Obvious?—Starve the Parasites"

FARM MANAGEMENT MOST IMPORTANT

(BY VETERINARIAN)

It was evident from the article on Saturday that the degree of infestation of sheep with parasites is largely a function of the method of management in the flock and its pastures.

To support under this heading to show the farmer in what manner he can adopt his system of management to one of the methods of infestation in the flock, and to show further how the effects of infestation can be decreased by maintaining his sheep in a well-managed state.

It has been shown without doubt today why also decrease the chain one of parasites living in the pasture and at the same time, make the sheep more and more susceptible to the same parasites without ill effect but in those cases where the parasites are within the sheep. These would be those cases where the parasites are not so numerous as to be able to be exterminated, that sheep which could withstand a high degree of parasites without harmful effects would be those which would be able to do so by decreasing the food supply.

Care of the Milking Ewe

The importance of providing the greatest in pasture for the milking ewe is a matter of great importance. Lushness should be so regulated that it never allows the ewe to take abundant food for the maximum time of a week supply of milk, and the ewe should be kept in good condition which should not allow her to decrease in weight. Ewe care is required as early as possible in the autumn, and the ewe should be kept in good condition for at least 9 months before she is put to the test. High in alternative system, the ewe should be kept in good condition at all times.

Management of Pastures

Every farmer's care should be given to the management of his pastures. The most available form of fertilizer is the best available for barbed wire. 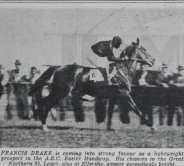
