German Firms Dismissing Employees: Similar Action in Sweden

LONDON, Dec. 9.—The German firms carrying on business in England have been ordered to dismiss all Jews, the Reich Ministry of Propaganda has announced.

The Reich Ministry says that it has been known for some time that German employees in London have been seeking Jewish friends, particularly disaffected and forwarding them.

A message from Goebbels (secret part) says that the Foreign Office (Mr. B. B. Baer) during a speech, said that German firms were to dismiss all Jews from Germany by 15th December.

Sweden was informed of the unwillingness of having non-Aryan employees and were asked to dismiss these employees and shareholders.

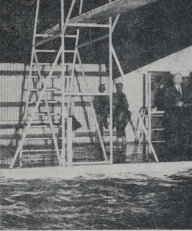

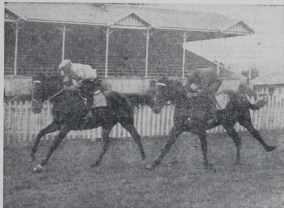

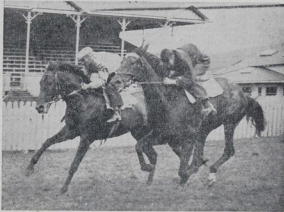

Attorney-General Explains That "Conversion" Is Not A Minor Crime

By Telegraph-Press Association.

The question of motor-car thefts and their prevention was the subject of a historical address given by the Attorney-General (the Hon. H. G. M. Mason) who emphasized for the benefit of police officers that there was adequate punishment for the crime.

"I notice the renewed circulation of a suggestion that the law is too lenient on the theft of motor-cars," said Mason. "This suggestion is not calculated to increase the respectability of those who steal cars, but it is to be deprecated and proscribed by legal newspapers. I feel bound to issue a correction."

"Under section 243 of the Crimes Act, a person who steals a motor-car is liable to imprisonment for not more than five years, or to a fine of not more than £500, or to both. This is the maximum penalty for the crime. It is not a minor crime, but a serious one."
