A FEW VALUABLE FIRST AID HINTS

Precautions To Take Until The Doctor Arrives

That little knowledge which is held to be "a dangerous thing" will in cases of accidents, which will occur in even the best regulated homes, help to alleviate pain and prevent unnecessary damage being done.

It is not suggested that first aid should take the place of expert medical aid, but that it should be practised until the doctor arrives—should the case be considered sufficiently serious to merit medical assistance.

Of course, there are many minor accidents which may occur at any time, particularly where there are children, and for these emergencies the mother or guardian should be prepared.

IT IS in a place like a knee or a foot that the most serious accidents are likely to occur. In such cases, the first aid should be to stop the bleeding, if any, and to apply a bandage to the wound. If the injury is to a limb, it should be supported and elevated above the level of the heart.

NEEDLE IN HAND OR FOOT—If a needle or pin has been stuck into the hand or foot, it should be removed as soon as possible. If it is in the hand, it should be removed from the palm side. If it is in the foot, it should be removed from the sole side.

SOMETHING IN THE EYE—If a foreign body has got into the eye, it should be removed as soon as possible. If it is a small particle, it can be removed with a clean cloth. If it is a larger object, it should be removed with a pair of tweezers.

INSECT IN THE EAR—If an insect has got into the ear, it should be removed as soon as possible. If it is a fly, it can be removed with a clean cloth. If it is a beetle, it can be removed with a pair of tweezers.

A BURNED HEEL—If a person has a burn on their heel, it should be treated with a clean cloth and a little oil. If the burn is severe, it should be treated with a doctor.

WATER SUPPLY FOR THE WAIROA DAIRY FACTORY

Successful Experiments May Lead To New Installation

"Daily Mail" Special Service. WAIROA.

Progressive steps are being taken by the Wairoa Dairy Co. in the development of an adequate water supply at the factory.

Following successful experiments with an air lift pump at the dairy factory on Thursday afternoon, it is probable that the directors of the company will install a similar pump with a view to supplying the factory with a much greater volume of water than is obtainable at present.

In an endeavour to supply the factory with water at a low temperature, the company made an experiment with a submersible pump which was being pumped 60 gallons of water an hour. This had been achieved by means of a 1/2 inch diameter pipe. The installation of this pump was the first of a series of experiments which the company has been carrying out at the factory since the installation of the "Daily Mail" representative visited the factory on Thursday afternoon, when the experiments were carried out.
