"HITLER WILL MAKE PEACE GESTURE WORLD"

IMPORTANT MESSAGE TO MR CHAMBERLAIN FROM THE REICH CHANCELLOR

DRAMATIC DEVELOPMENT IN EUROPEAN SITUATION HEER HITLER INCLINING TOWARDS PEACE

London, September 12. (Revised September 12, 12.30 a.m.)
THE "DAILY MAIL" HAS RECEIVED A MESSAGE FROM HEER HITLER, AS A RESULT OF WHICH HE BELIEVES THAT HEER HITLER TO-NIGHT WILL MAKE A PEACE GESTURE TO THE WORLD.
The message was brought to the Prime Minister by Lord Brocket, who arrived today by air.
Heer Hitler is scheduled to speak at Nuremberg between 7 p.m. and 8 p.m. on Monday, English Summer Time.
Berlin advisers think it is most likely that it will be about 7.30 p.m.

[This corresponds approximately with eight o'clock this morning, New Zealand time.]
Heer Hitler's speech is awaited in London with certain anxiety, in view of how much is believed to turn upon it, but it is not forgotten that Heer Hitler has repeatedly expressed his desire for peace, and in all responsible quarters here there is every disposition to assume his sincerity.
A previous message from Nuremberg said that Heer Hitler had been visited by foreign journalists. He appeared to be very happy, laughing and joking. He did not refer to the war.
It is believed he reviewed 10,000 troops, who goose-stepped past him.

The "Daily Mail" correspondent, Mr. Ward Price, from Nuremberg says that while Heer Hitler will not say or do anything which brings a risk, he may not say or do anything of the sort which gives cause for alarm.
The Sudeeten leaders say that a recognition of the German foreign position policy, for instance the alliance with the Soviet, will be an essential feature of any settlement. The German press in Nuremberg is saying that Heer Hitler will not only strongly declare Germany's determination to see the German position in Europe, but that Heer Hitler will make a bid to the breaking of negotiations.
The following is thought to be the gist of the message to Chamberlain which Heer Hitler will participate.

Heer Hitler says from Prague that Germany has, at the last minute, withdrawn her delegates from the International Statistical Conference.

In Berlin 900 electricians worked throughout the night to ensure that the city will hear Heer Hitler's speech.
A million buses, ships, factories, cinema, and restaurants are being prepared for the occasion.
The speech will be relayed throughout the country and will be transmitted to foreign stations.
A further 2500 fortification workers are reported to have gone to Sudeeten.




