Explanation Is Requested

MARTIAL LAW NOW ENFORCED IN NINETEEN DISTRICTS

Czech Cabinet Still In Session

Prague, Sept. 20. (Associated Press.)—A special correspondent of "The Times," reporting from Prague early in the morning, stated that no decision had yet been reached, although several members of the Czechoslovakian Cabinet were known to favour the acceptance of the Anglo-French plan.

His message from Prague says that the Czech Cabinet resumed at 11 a.m., President Benes presiding.

The report is still unconfirmed.

Benes's persists that the plan has been accepted in principle as the basis of negotiations, but states that further explanation has been requested.

Martial law has been extended to three further districts. It is now being enforced in 19.

EUROPE EXPERIENCES A COMPLETE LULL

Czech Decision Is Awaited

PRAGUE CALM, BUT INTENSELY EXPECTANT

Prague, Sept. 20. (Associated Press.)—Since early morning reports that the Czechs favour provisional acceptance of the Anglo-French peace plan, there has been complete lull throughout Europe, apart from the exchange of negative messages, through the Prague office meeting at 11 a.m.

The decision of this meeting is regarded as the last one of the kind.

Further moves by the French and British Cabinet and also the Chamber of Deputies are dependent on the official Czech statement after the closing of the Cabinet meeting.

In the meantime, Prague is calm and intensely expectant.

Efforts are made to maintain public order, but there is a strict watch on news being maintained, with restrictions have been placed on the use of electricity.

The general tone of the French Press with respect to the peace plan is "So, but necessary."

"GERMANY WILL PERMIT NO DELAY," IT IS SAID

Sensational Report Of Clash On Frontier: Village Attacked

Prague, Sept. 20. (Associated Press.)—It is authoritatively declared that Germany will not permit a delay in the settlement of the crisis by further diplomatic discussion.

The German army states that several hundred Czech soldiers, armed with machine-guns, attempted to cross the German frontier and seize Silesian territory on a camp at the frontier. It is alleged that they fired on the village of Hirschberg, but that German bullets were repelled.

It is reported that 17 Germans were injured.

Benes's Berlin correspondent reports that while officials are preparing for their talks with the Czechs, the possibility of even a suitable nation are being maintained.

The German Army corps commander has been commended.

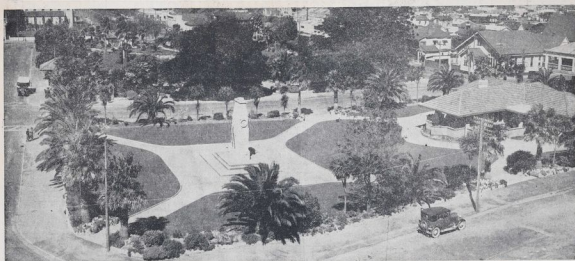

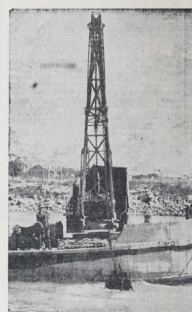

Why is the Labour Party ASHAMED OF SOCIALISM?

Have you noticed, during the past few months, how frequently Cabinet Ministers try to deny the Socialist label and doctrine? For instance, at Christchurch on August 22, the Minister of Railways said, "The opposition is... trying to deflect the minds of the people from the real election issue—by raising this bogey of Socialism."

This is in spite of the fact that the declared policy of the Labour Party is the "Socialisation of the means of Production, Distribution and Exchange."

Because he knows that Socialism is hateful to the majority of New Zealanders, Mr. Savage now says: "It is ridiculous to say that we are going to Socialise the land."

Look back a few months and remind yourself what some Ministers have said: "The object of the Labour Party is Socialism... I am a Socialist." — Mr. Armstrong at Christchurch, September 22, 1938. "The Labour Government stands unchanged in its principles from those it stood for thirty years ago, and it is still the same advocate of Socialism." — Mr. Wake at Kihirua, January 26, 1936.

Mr. Savage has confessed that his government has only gone "half the journey." This journey is towards the goal of Complete Socialism—and Socialism, according to the Oxford Dictionary definition, means "national ownership of land and capital—state distribution of produce—abolition of inheritance."

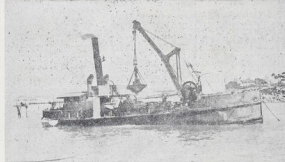
Socialism the First Stage of Communism.—Stalin has nothing to hide. Read his own definition of Socialism in his speech to the Eighth Congress of Soviets of U.S.S.R. in November, 1937.

"Our Soviet Society has already, in the main, succeeded in achieving Socialism; it has created a Socialist system, i.e., it has brought about what the Marxists call the first, or lower phase of Communism. Hence, in the main, we have already achieved the first phase of Communism—Socialism."

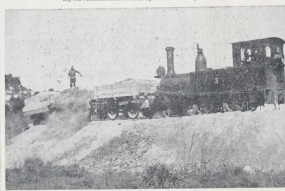

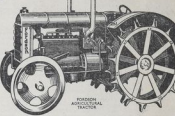

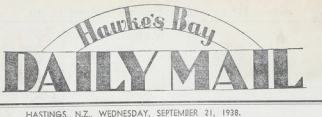
