CZECH MINGVINGS: OBJECTION TO HITLER'S DEMANDS

London, Sept. 29. A message from Geneva says that international opinion is strongly divided. Some feel that the conference between the four Powers is virtually a surrender to the dictators. The Russians are strongly against the conference, seeing in the London "Daily Telegraph" Franco conference signs to exclude Britain from the councils of Europe.

Other London message states that high placed officials say that, with reference to Mr. Lloyd's statement, that Herr Hitler claims areas where there is only 20 per cent of Germans, that it has only an isolated and negligible application. Herr Hitler's main, they say, is to force Germany to accept the Anglo-French proposed frontier.

The German News Agency has issued an official statement announcing that the conversations will begin in the following: "It is feared in well-informed quarters that new proposals for the solution of the crisis will be submitted to-day by the British as well as by the French Government."

While it is noted in France and Italy is not dispensed. German official circles, through expressing the hope that the conference will be successful. 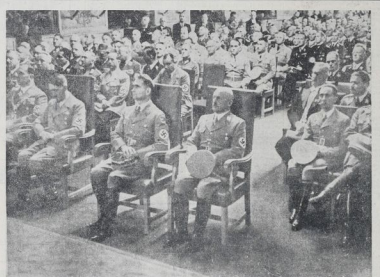

ITALIAN VOLUNTEERS TO LEAVE SPAIN

Implementing Anglo-Italian Pact

SERIOUS RIOTING REPORTED IN MILAN

Opposition To Fascist War Policy

Italian Foreign Minister (Ciano) is believed to have informed Lord Lloyd of a decision to withdraw Italian volunteers from Spain, intimating that the last detachment to the application of the Anglo-Italian Pact is already on its way.

It is understood here that the evacuation of Italians has already begun. It is reported from St. Jean de Luz that 500 Italian troops have been withdrawn already from the Spanish war.

Most of them were stationed at Gijón and Saragosa. Though Italian preparations for an emergency as far as they are restricted to the calling up of several companies of recruits and specialists, a warning has been issued to transport agents to hold themselves in readiness for mobilization.

The newspapers continue to support Germany. The Paris correspondent of the London "News Chronicle" says that it is believed that serious rioting has occurred in Milan this afternoon, and that it was continuing this evening.

A large crowd demonstrated against Herr Hitler's and Signor Mussolini's warlike policy, a story which it declares is fully supported by Italian deserters coming from the French front daily. Three senile officers are reported to be among the leaders.

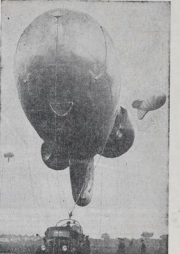
