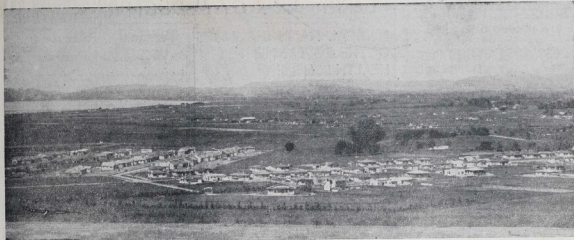

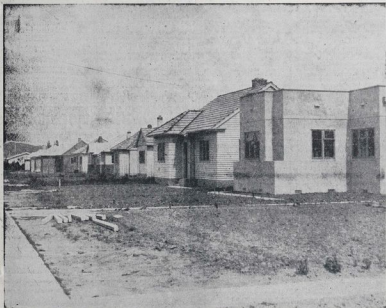

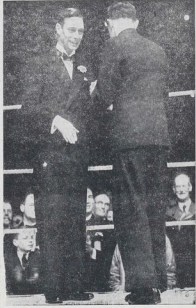

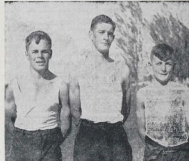

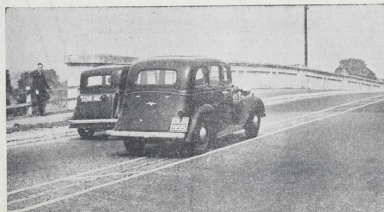

Free Choice of Doctor—An Illusion!

Under the proposed Social Security Medical Service, there cannot possibly be free choice of doctor, such as exists at present, because—

1. Each doctor will have a limited number of patients, and once his list is full no one else can choose him as a medical attendant until there is a vacancy on his list.
2. Free choice of doctor by the patient also means that there is free choice of patient by the doctor—a doctor need not have you on his list if you require much attention, or if you live too far away from him.
3. Unless you are prepared to pay EXTRA for mileage if you live far from the doctor of your choice, you will have to go to one nearby or the nearest doctor.
4. Once you are on a doctor's list, you can only see other doctors you may choose if you pay EXTRA over and above your weekly contribution.
5. To-day 20,000 people can choose to have a particular doctor when they need him, because all are not ill at once. Under the Social Security Scheme only a limited number of people will ever be ill at once, and that doctor unless they pay EXTRA.
6. If you wish to be operated on by a doctor of your own choice, you may have to pay EXTRA for the operation.

In the end you will have to take any doctor who may be allotted to you, unless you get in early on the list of the one you want, and even then you may not be accepted IF YOU LIVE FAR AWAY.

Higher Hospital Costs!

The proposed scheme of free hospital treatment means much higher costs of hospitals because—

1. Much larger hospitals will be required to house the people when they can go in free and get their wages partly paid while they are in hospital. Enormous capital expenditure will be necessary—it costs £1000 per bed to build new hospitals.
2. There will need to be an enormous increase in out-patient departments. This has happened all over the world on institution of even limited, not universal, health services.
3. Much larger staffs will be required in all departments of hospitals—enormous increase in salaries will result.
4. To-day all treatment and operations performed in large hospitals are done by honorary physicians and surgeons who give their services free. Under the proposed scheme, if all doctors attend in free in public hospitals, these doctors will have to be paid. To pay such medical attention it runs into thousands of pounds per year.
5. To-day all treatment and operations performed in large hospitals are done by honorary physicians and surgeons who give their services free. Under the proposed scheme, if all doctors attend in free in public hospitals, these doctors will have to be paid. To pay such medical attention it runs into thousands of pounds per year.
6. At present, it costs approximately 15/- per day per bed in public hospitals—about 2/6 per day is collected—12/6 has to be found, 6/3 by the general taxpayer from consolidated fund—and 6/3 by local taxes and rates. Under the proposed scheme 6/- per day is to be paid into Hospital Boards 9/- per day will have to be found—but when hospitals are doubled in size, it will be equivalent to having to find 18/- per bed (as they exist to-day). In other words, hospital costs must rise, especially for farmers. Medical attention costs at these new rates plus 1/- in the £1 per week will be heavy.
6. All hospital services will have to be enlarged. 1. Salaries will rise and costs will mount steadily, resulting in heavier taxation.

Poor Standard of Medical Attention!

It is claimed that the Social Security Medical Service will give a better standard of medical care. This is wrong because:

1. There is already a higher grade of service in New Zealand than in many other countries because of the isolation and nature of the country; because 75% of doctors have been abroad for post-graduate teaching; because a very large number have higher degrees and specialised knowledge. All visiting authorities admit New Zealand's high average of medical service. Under the proposed scheme doctors will not go abroad in such large numbers if the incentive and competitive spirit is lost.
2. Under the proposed scheme doctors can and will go straight into practice from the medical school without post-graduate work at all—they will be sure of a full list and an income. They will ultimately set the standard, that is, that of the newest qualified doctor available.
3. There is no provision for specialists at all, and they will tend to go out of existence. The result will be that the example of high-grade work will be lost to the profession, and gradually a poorer type of work will result.
4. The slowest and worst doctor will tend ultimately to set the standard—this must be so. Doctors only have to do for the patients on their list what an ordinary general practitioner can do, otherwise some patients will get more than others for their contributions, which would not agree with the socialist ideals. All in the end come down to the lowest standard.
5. The tendency in time will be for doctors to try to get the limit number of patients on their list and not worry about going abroad at all, which means that a lower grade medical attention will follow.
6. There will always be people who will want a little more and who will pay extra—two types of practice will result—a "panel" type under the Social Security Scheme SECOND CLASS, and those who pay—FIRST CLASS.
7. The close confidential and personal association between you and your doctor must gradually disappear when you become one of a list of patients of so much a head.
