Labour Returned With A Large Majority

Few Sensations In Final Returns

SOME SEATS ARE STILL IN DOUBT

Several National Gains

MR A. E. JULL WINS WAIPAWA FROM LABOUR

Mr J. A. Lee's Enormous Majority

New Zealand's first Labour Government was returned to power by an overwhelming majority of electors on Saturday. Although the National Party captured a number of seats, the result was as decisive as that of the general election of 1935. The Labour Party secured a total of 54 seats, as compared with 25 National Party seats and two Independents.

The National Party, in addition to retaining most of its seats, regained the following—Franklin, Hauraki, Manawatu (which embraces the old Otago electorate), Rangitikei, Tairāneia, Waikato, Mataura, and Waitaki; while New Plymouth, Motueka, and Riccarton were lost to the Labour Party.

The Labour Party won Bay of Islands, which was formerly held by Captain H. M. Rushworth (Country Party), and Wellington West (a new electorate).

The Mid-Canterbury seat, which on Saturday night appeared to have been won from Labour by the National candidate, is still in doubt. Although the National candidate is leading by 48 votes, a total of 670 votes have yet to be accounted for.

The Hawke's Bay North, Gisborne, Bay of Plenty, Botorua, and Pahiatua seats remained unchanged, but Mr A. E. Jull (National) secured the Waipawa seat from the sitting member (Mr H. M. Christie, Labour).

In the licensing poll, a substantial lead was established by Continence over both Rate Control and Prohibition. The latest available figures are as follows:—
