In a note to the question it was stated: "In Hawke's Bay in February and in Poverty Bay in March, there was unusually severe and heavy rainfall resulting in almost total destruction of crops, and in others severe losses to orchards and farmers. The weather forecasts gave little or no warning of these exceptionally heavy rains."



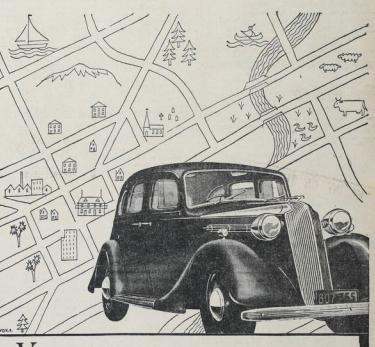

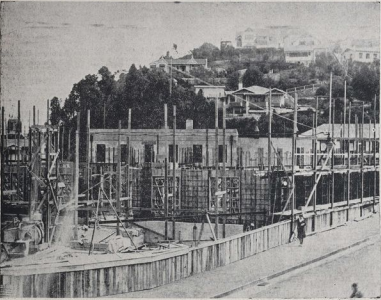
