Mr. Chamberlain Says Britain's Attitude Not Affected By Mr. Eden's Resignation

RUGBY, March 2.

Mr. Arthur Henderson (Lab.) said the Prime Minister (Mr. Neville Chamberlain) in the House of Commons yesterday, in view of the recent resignation by the French Foreign Minister (M. Delbos) that France introduced action in application of Article 17 of the Covenant to assist Czechoslovakia. If that country was attacked by Germany, he would state in such circumstances Britain intended under the same article to assist France and Czechoslovakia.

Mr. Chamberlain replied that the position of Britain with special reference to Central Europe was stated by Mr. Eden in the House of Commons in June, and he had nothing to add to that.
