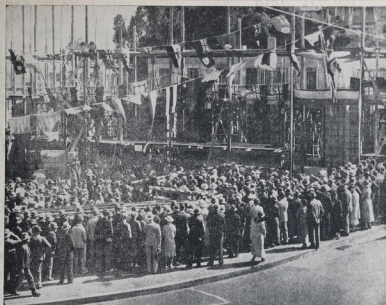

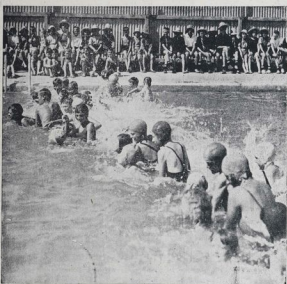

# Three thousand troops march on Austria

## MAIN CENTRES OCCUPIED

### Soldiers Fraternise

#### WAS INVASION AT REQUEST OF DR. INAUART?

LONDON, March 13.  
It is believed that between 90,000 and 100,000 German troops under the command of General Beckenbauer entered Austria, occupying all the important centres. Austrian and German troops are fraternising everywhere.

Some hours before the German troops crossed the frontier it was officially announced in Berlin that an Inquest had interrogated Herr Hitler as follows: "The provisional Government, which after the resignation of Dr. Schuschnigg's Government was in its task of maintaining order and peace in Austria, and in Austria, according to the German Government an urgent request to support it in the task and help preventing bloodshed. 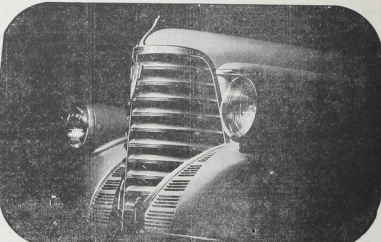

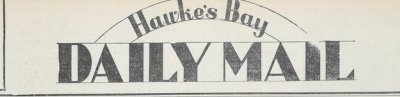
