## VIENNA CROWDS BAIT JEWS

### Nazi Seizure of Their Property Has Begun in Austria

### Vote is Taken Away

It is still impossible to obtain details of the enormous numbers of articles carried out by Sturm Troopers and police forces today, but it is feared that practically the whole of the Government Press Department has been impounded.

At present, Jewish cafes, shops and hotels are being searched throughout Vienna by Nazis.

Dr. Julius Streicher, the German race-baiter, has left for Vienna to direct anti-Jewish measures.

It is reported that the Vienna Jewish community has been ordered to hand over all their property to the Government.

The Minister of Justice, Herr Schickel, has been ordered to discontinue all Jewish or half-Jewish marriages.

Sturm troops and other Nazis are patrolling the streets in Vienna to prevent any form of disturbance in the population.

All civilian workers are ordered to report to the Austrian Police, who have taken over the Austrian Press and the Austrian Government.

The Minister of Justice, Herr Schickel, has been ordered to discontinue all Jewish or half-Jewish marriages.

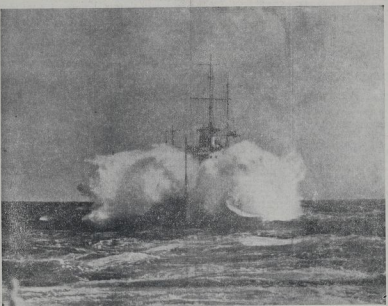
### Bavarian Frontier Also Closed

## ITALY DECIDES ON HUGE NAVAL BUILDING PROGRAMME

### 690,000 Tons of Naval Craft Will be Constructed in Three Years

Admiral Domenico Cavagnari informed the Chamber of Deputies that Italy was launching the laying down of over 200,000 tons of new warships, the aggregate tonnage of her navy by 1941 being:

Battleships, 240,000 tons.  
Cruisers, 160,000 tons.  
Light surface craft, 190,000 tons.  
Submarines, 100,000 tons.

The Chamber approved naval appropriations amounting to £20,000,000.

The Italian Navy at present include two battleships of 35,000 tons each, two old Dreadnought battleships, 17 modern cruisers, 17 light surface craft (including motor torpedo-boats) and 41 submarines.

When current building is completed, comparative figures for the British Navy will be:

Battleships, 543,000 tons.  
Cruisers, 360,000 tons.  
Light surface craft, 200,000 tons (approx.).  
Submarines, 65,000 tons.

## LOYALISTS IN DESPERATE SITUATION

### Flood of Fascist Troops is Reported

### 2000 Miles of Territory is Taken in Six Days

LONDON, March 16.—The gravity of the Loyalist situation in Spain becomes more and more obvious. The Spanish Embassy in London declares that Germany is preparing fresh invasion, having been dispatched on March 14 30,000 Sturm Troops, while reports from Hendaye assert that a large contingent of German widows and aviation technicians landed at Pamplona.

The "Daily Telegraph" Paris correspondent says that the Loyalist situation is regarded as desperate, their reverse being regarded as solely due to the recent flooding of German and Italian reinforcements.

In Berlin, however, official circles categorically deny that Sturm Troops have been sent to Spain.

The rebels are sweeping to the sea after capturing 2000 miles in six days, including four towns and 60 villages. Their advance is threatening to render Catalonia from the remainder of Spain. An important rebel success is the capture of Caceres, 15 miles north of Alcala.

A Paris cable states that the Spanish Ambassador visited the French Prime Minister (Dr. Bon) and the Foreign Minister (M. Bonnet). It is understood they stated that Catalonia contemplates proclaiming herself an independent State and requests the assistance of France if General Franco reaches the Catalan border.

France replied that she would continue non-intervention as long as other Powers abtained direct intervention.

The Spanish Embassy in London states that the Catalans are not seeking a separate peace, nor has the Spanish Ambassador in Paris asked for Spanish help.

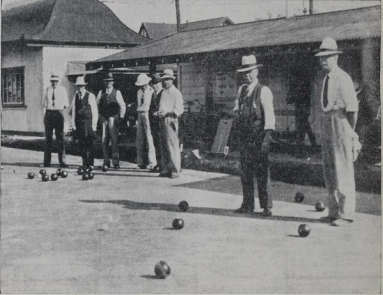

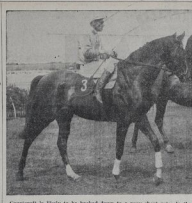
