Clouston At Blenheim : All Records Broken

DARING ATTEMPT SUCCEEDS

Fastest Journey Yet Between England and Dominion

TUMULTUOUS WELCOME

Seven Hours Ten Minutes From Sydney

By Telegraph-Press Association. BLENHEIM, March 20.

Completing the fastest journey ever made between England and New Zealand, the Dominion-bound Royal Air Force aircraft, flying Officer A. E. Clouston, with an English journalist, a Mr Victor Bolesta, as companion, landed the famous Comet monoplane at the Blenheim airport this afternoon.

The Comet was the 'Blainie out from Sydney—a record for the Tassan crossing—and 4 days 8 hr 7 min from England, after a new record and slashing 6 days 12 hr out of New Britain's sole take.

Three thousand enthusiastic people gave the flyers a warm welcome when Flying Officer Clouston brought down his machine to a perfect landing and taxied towards the hangar. After a long and anxious wait, the people surged forward past the barriers as the plane approached, and despite the order given to remain where they were, the excitement and the desire to see the machine so close to hand, the flyers would not be mobbed. However, the officials, police, firemen and territorial party, who had been absent about the crowd, managed to get the Comet to a certain point but left the welcoming party at a safe distance.

Clouston had been expected an hour earlier. As he took off from Sydney at 8.30 a.m. (New Zealand time) and averaged 200 miles an hour, he was expected at Blenheim in six hours. However, adverse conditions over the Tassan resulted in his hour's delay and the wheels touched ground at 4.47 p.m.

Down Coast From Egmont

Having made a landing at Mount Egmont, the Comet came down the coast and through Cook Strait. The rise at which the machine increased in speed after it had been indicated her great speed, and as the aircraft part of the circuit, her ultra-stunning and pace made her look like a speed-wrecked bullet. The machine was already at a low altitude, but, apparently with the intention of familiarizing himself with the field in view of the take-off on the return journey, Clouston made no fewer than six circuits before leaving the Comet down.

As she made a landing, room, pulling up with more than half a ton of weight.

The crowd surged round the machine Clouston opened the roof of the cockpit and waved a cheery greeting. After conferring with the crew of the Aero Club (Mr MacNab) as to the housing of the Comet, he taxied the machine to the hangar, where the machine was most safely accommodated under the watchful eyes of pilots.

On being over-arrived, the flyers had to undergo medical and Customs examinations. This, the ceremony completed, they were escorted to a temporary club, where a formal welcome was extended by Mr MacNab, the Mayor of Blenheim (Mr J. Stevenson) and the Minister of Public Works (the Hon. R. Sefton), who came specially from Kaitiaki to represent the Government.

U.S. REBUFF FOR GERMANY LITHUANIA ACCEPTS POLISH "FRIENDSHIP" TERMS: CRISIS IS AVERTED

Not Recognising Austrian Coup—General Rejoicing Prevails Among People When News is Known

The American Secretary of State (Mr. Cordell Hull) indicated that the United States will not recognize, at least at present, the legality of Germany's annexation of Austria, says the United Press correspondence. This followed an intimation from Henry Ford, that the affairs of the Austrian Republic had been absorbed by the German Reich. Mr. Hull indicated that the United States Government would not recognize Austria as a representative republic of Austria. This is a serious matter, says the United Press, because the larger question of the legality of the union between the two countries.

The extent to which the American people are shocked is estimated to be the most important of present-day news. It is believed that this Government is likely to make a serious attempt to bring the United States and Mr. Hull.

The Soviet has abandoned the policy of non-recognition of the Anschluss, including the Polish Republic (Mr. Lavrentiev). Colonel G. G. Zhukov, the Russian Minister of War, has stated that the Soviet Government will help to aid in Polish Lithuanian efforts.

Calculations of the settlement of the dispute involving Poland's claims on the basis of an agreement made during the war of 1914-18, says the United Press, are now being made by the Government.

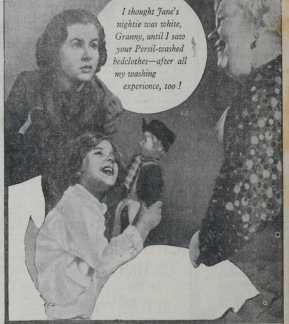

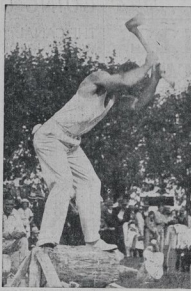

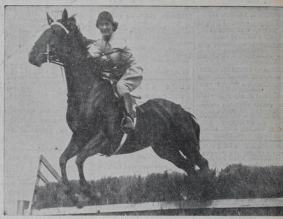
