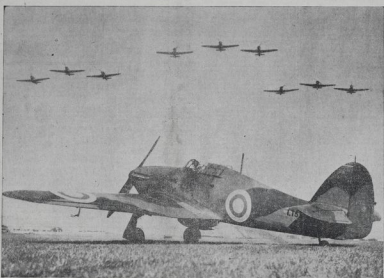

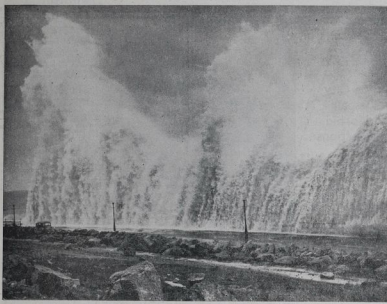

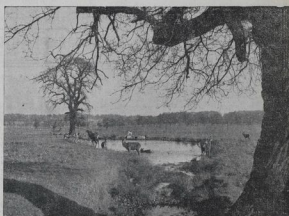

Local History During Forty Years

Interesting events in Napier during the last 40 years are recalled by a collection of programmes that has been given to the Healey's Day Museum by Messrs R. and Th. Elliott, of Napier. The collection ranges from the Diamond Jubilee of Queen Victoria in 1867 to the present day.
