CANBERRA, March 24.

Outlining the most sensational defence proposals ever brought forward in Australia, the Federal Prime Minister (Mr. J. A. Lyons) to-night said that the Commonwealth had decided on an expenditure of £25,000,000 in the next three years on the maintenance and development of defence forces.

This unprecedented total will comprise £12,000,000 additional new expenditures, spread over three years, and £13,000,000 which will represent normal ordinary commitments over three years of maintenance of defence forces on the existing scale.

Mr Lyons said the vital importance of the programme, Australia was called on to defend itself—

(1) The first essential of any modern State, both at home and overseas.
(2) The maintenance of the highest integrity of the Commonwealth which would be essential to the success of any programme.
(3) The new defence units which will be added during the next three years are—

MOOSE NUTS AND MEAL

CAN MEN RUN A 4-MINUTE MILE?

Falling Records in Last 100 Years Suggest it is Possible

Running is perhaps the most primitive of sports, old as the human race, and an universally distributed. The mile is probably the most universal of distances. For speed and for a test of stamina, it is a small wonder that that of the mile is asked "Can men run a 4-minute mile?"

The question is asked in the American "Sports Illustrated" as now named as will record of 30s. In fact on the day Stockholm track in 1924, runners have arisen as fast as the limit of the human race. The record that Norman Tait would stand for 20 years.

It is now known better than ever that the mile record would be lowered and lowered often, and it should be attributed to his conviction that a four-minute mile was within human grasp.

But he was right. Laboratory, a mile in 4 min. 20 sec. in 1908, in 32 sec. Within a year, however, the American, John Carlin, brought the time to 4 min. 7.4 sec. In the 1920s, track work with the mile, the American, Jimmie Hagan, ran the mile in 4 min. 17.7 sec. Americans thought confidently that one runner had not run a 4 min. mile and last time for human performance.
