Sailors' Discovery Under Wharf
Clues To Identify
Ghastly Crime A Complete Mystery

BLENNHEIM, May 8.

Bearing three stab marks in the vicinity of the heart, the limbless and legless body of an elderly, slimy-built man was found packed in a fibre suitcase floating under the Pictou wharf last night on Saturday.

An unemployment key book, found in a coat pocket when the body was examined by detectives late in the afternoon, disclosed that it was the property of Edwin Armstrong, of 20 Hinau Road, Hataitai, Wellington. According to information given the police from Wellington, Armstrong was last seen at 8:30 on Friday morning, when his wife and two sons, the latter aged 19 and 20 respectively, left for their work in the city.

TO THE RATEPAYERS OF HAWKE'S BAY COUNTY

The question of RATING is once again to be decided at a poll on Wednesday next, May 11th.

Ratepayers will be asked to decide whether on Unimproved Values shall be abolished with reversion to Rating on Capital Values.

Now a petition for another poll has been very quietly circulated and very cleverly drafted by the Council, being made public only when it was required by law to advertise the poll.

Needless to say, the changeover has been made in order to give relief where most necessary, i.e., to the smallholder who had hitherto been penalised for every improvement he had struggled to make on his property.
