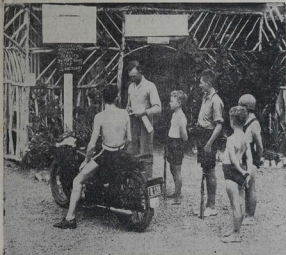

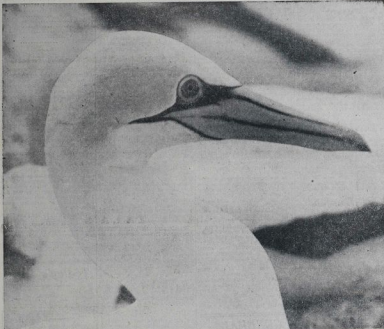
**ON THE WAY TO THE SANCTUARY.**—It is necessary for visitors to procure permits from the warden at the Clifton House. The road ends here and visitors must begin the four-mile journey along the beach.



**A WELL-KNOWN FIGURE.**—Mr. W. N. Stanley, secretary manager and caretaker of the Clifton House. Permits to visitors are issued at his office on the way to the Cape. The book which he keeps contains names of visitors from all parts of the world.



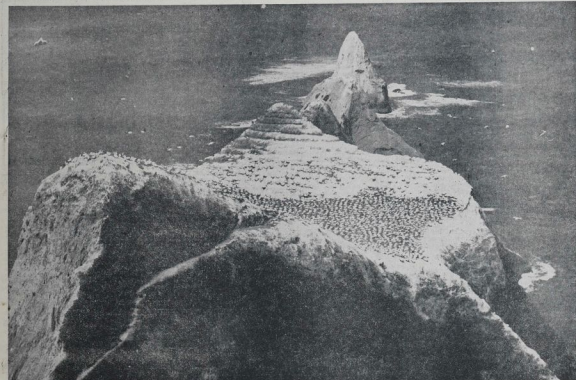
**WHERE SEA, SKY AND LAND MEET.**—The cape was from the beach. At low water motorcars may be used, but at certain stages of tides is inadvisable. Motorcycles and bicycles are completely safe, but must prefer to walk. The road is firm, but scattered rocks are likely to be the downfall of the unwary driver.



**FORBIDDING BEAK AND WARY EYE.**—The close approach of the camera did not drive this bird from her nest, although she was obviously nervous and ready to flight the moment the camera stopped. The first one and the head distinctly marked with yellow skin, and the second was grey at about six feet. The bill is longer and steeper than that of the gull.



**HATCHING IS IN FULL SWING.**—The colony is crowded with nesting birds. Petticoats and pelicans nests. Overcrowding has resulted in some of the birds leaving the colony and seeking their nests at Bluff Reef, a short distance along the road. This is the first season in which gannets have bred successfully at the reef, but they have worked on higher rocks and so avoiding the attention of curious fishermen.



**GENERAL VIEW OF THE COLONY.**—Access to the sanctuary has been considerably improved in recent years. Leaving the beach the visitor climbs a path which traverses some country before descending to the place where the permits are issued. Entrances are protected by high pillars even from the birds, and entry above the walls of these houses. It is estimated that 4000 permits are available at the colony this year.

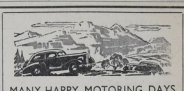

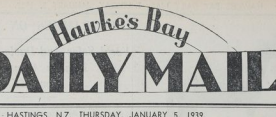
