SPECIAL CONSTABLES ARE CALLED UP**Drastic Ulster Action To Combat Bombings****LONDON POLICE ACTIVE**

LONDON, Jan. 20.

Hundreds of detectives throughout London are seeking the hiding-place where quantities of explosives may still be stored. County police too, are active.

Home Office officials report that, in addition to 3000 regular police, the Ulster Government has called up 3000 special constables to assist the police and volunteers, and ordered them to prevent bomb outrages.

A patrol each night covers all public buildings, gas works, power stations, post offices, banks and premises of utilities.

It is understood that Ulster Ministers will shortly be going to London to discuss the steps to be taken to prevent the commission of outrages.

Two men, one a policeman and two detectives escort the Colonial Secretary (Mr. Malcolm McDonald) in the course of a visit to Dinsdale, Lancashire.

The Home Office is investigating an unexploded bomb found near a pub at Windsor.

Mr. Frank Charnier, State High Commissioner, has apportioned to Mr. Charnier himself the task of dealing with the explosion.

An American cable message states that British police are of the opinion that many Britishers who came to Ulster during the recent disturbances were responsible for the centres in order to survey the ground and to choose the best places to plant bombs.

Many anonymous letters, some threatening and some with warnings regarding the recent bombing, have been sent to British police, but the police do not attach much importance to them.

The Home Office theorizes that a number of Indians living semi-permanently in England are aiding the plotters either directly or indirectly.

India's expenses amounted to £1,000 a month, it is believed, in which Frank Charnier, State High Commissioner, was instrumental.

Mr. Charnier, who has been in England since the last war, has been a guest of the British Government on several occasions, and has been received by King George VI and Queen Elizabeth.

Frank Charnier arrived at Tilbury on Friday 16 for a short stay, and was accompanied by three members of his staff, all gaily attired by three dressmakers, who had to be coaxed into the uniform of the Indian civil service, car with which he went up an express train to London.

Mr. Charnier was not permitted to leave the country without a permit.

Republican Army.—The authorities are watching on the movements of the Republicans, who are holding the week of the fifth Biennium.

Members of the Civil Guard, said to be the most extreme body made from the hard core of the Falange, were seen to be marching through the streets of Madrid, shouting their slogan, "Death to the Republic."

It was reported that the march was seriously intended.




