Nationalist Policy After British Recognition AZANA TO RESIGN

British Official Wireless. (Received February 26, p.m.) When, as is anticipated, the Prime Minister (Mr Neville Chamberlain) announces in the House of Commons on Monday the decision to extend full diplomatic recognition to the Government of Spain, he will probably indicate that certain general instructions, based on a statement by General Franco, have been received as to the principles which will guide the head of the Nationalist Government in administering justice in the remaining Republican areas, when those areas are taken over.

Although these assurances are invariably stated only in broad terms, they are regarded in London as evidence that general reprisals against political leaders on the Republican side will be avoided.

The "Daily Mail" Sir Jean De Las correspondents say that General Franco has promised a full official amnesty, provided the Republicans surrender unconditionally, and that the amnesty is not a condition of British or French recognition. The offer has been commented on by the British and French envoys, Sir Robert Hodgson and Senator Berch.
