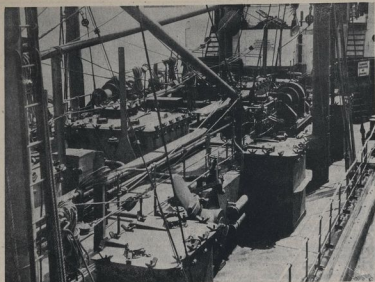

ARMY ROUTINE GOES ON.—Spanish Republican troops who have found refuge in France.



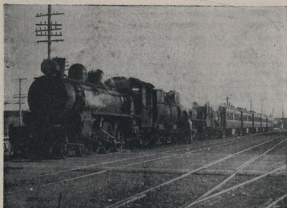

BOMB DOOR TESTS.—A 100 lb. bomb being placed only five floors during the experiment in London to test the value of bomb defectors.



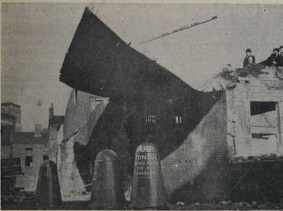

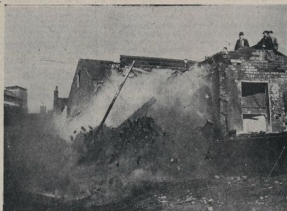

Minister Calls Conference Of Interests: Desire For Co-operation

By Telegraph-Press Association. WELLINGTON, March 3. "In response to representations made to me the road transport industry I decided some time ago to hold a conference of representatives of the Railways Department, transport interests and the Transport Department to consider the problem of the co-ordination of road and freight transport services in the Dominion," said the Minister of Transport (Hon. E. Searles), tonight.

The conference commenced last Wednesday and lasted for five days. A comprehensive agenda of subjects for discussion and a report embodying the proceedings at the conference are being prepared. The Minister said that he was pleased to prepare for consideration by the Government.

"I had the pleasure of addressing the conference on the opening of the conference and the obvious desire for co-operation between rail and road freight transport services, and I would like to express the thanks of the Government to those who took part in the conference."
