FAST EXPENDITURE FOR BRITISH AIR DEFENCE
Estimates Increased Twofold In Last Five Years: Modern Planes in Production

British Official Wireless. (Received March 10, 10:37 p.m.)
Introducing the largest Air Estimates in the history of the Air Ministry, totalling £220,000,000, the Air Minister (Sir George Trevelyan) outlined the House of Commons that in 1934 the Air Estimates would amount to about £100,000,000. This year they were over twice their former figure. In a year from 1929 to 1934, and roughly double the aggregate expenditure on the three services in 1932 and 1933.

It explained that the heavy expenditure this year was due mainly to the large number of modern aircraft now coming into production, the cost of providing additional manufacturing plants, and the construction of new stations.
It was accounted for, too, by the fact that the cost of modern aircraft is increasing rapidly. The cost of a modern fighter is now about £10,000, compared with £3,000 in 1934.

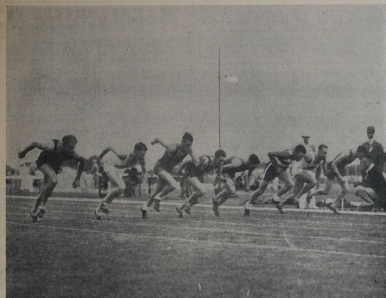

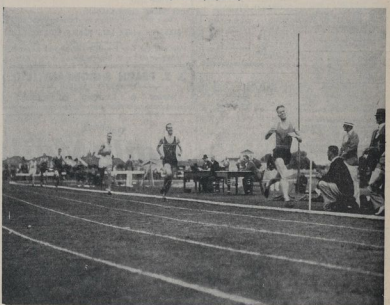

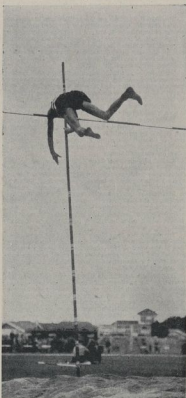
