SLOVAKIA AND RUTHENIA ARE NOW INDEPENDENT

Czech Army Warned Not to Resist: "Brutality" Threatened

DRAMATIC NEW DEVELOPMENTS

With dramatic swiftness events in Czechoslovakia have moved towards an epic climax. Messages received by cable up to the early hours of this morning reveal a confused situation in Europe, but it is clear that independent Czechoslovakia has ceased to exist.

At 5 a.m. yesterday German troops began to occupy the Czech state, the Czech army being instructed not to resist under penalty of the intervention "becoming utterly brutal." Later it was officially announced in Berlin that "Her Hitler had taken the Czech people under his protection."

Simultaneously the independence of Slovakia and Ruthenia were proclaimed. There is much disorder and fighting between factional groups and the troops of the Powers interested.

An official communique has been issued which says that Herr Hitler has advised the Czech people about the protection of the German Reich. It is a solemn declaration that the German Reich will be guaranteed by the German Reich, and an agreement along those lines has been signed by Herr Hitler, Dr. Hacha, Herr von Ribbentrop, and the Czech Foreign Minister (M. Chvalavsky).

In order to reach final agreement, Dr. Hacha placed the fate of the Czech people and their land trustfully in the hands of the Fuhrer, and the Fuhrer accepted.

The conversations between Herr Hitler and Dr. Hacha ended at 5.5 a.m. Dr. Hacha was very grave as he drove away to his hotel.

He decided to make a statement to the effect that Germany received full authority of all parts.

It was earlier reported by "The Times" representative in Prague that it was believed that Dr. Hacha offered Germany a cautious notice to prevent German occupation of the Czech State.

CZECH ARMY DISARMED AS ADVANCE CONTINUES

PRAGUE ADVISES SURRENDER

LONDON, March 15.

The Prague wireless announced at 5 a.m. Greenwich Mean Time, that German troops had occupied Czech territory.

The British United Press correspondent at Vienna says that they occupied Prague.

The Prague wireless stated that the Czech army will be disarmed as the Germans move there. Appeals are being broadcast every 15 minutes that the Czech army should not resist the German occupation, adding: "Arms must not be rendered without hesitation."

An official statement announced that the German advance must not be resisted, otherwise it would cause the most unforeseen consequences, leading to the intervention becoming utterly futile.

"All commanders must obey the orders of the occupying army."

The Czech army will be disarmed. Military and civil aeroplanes must remain at aerodromes, and none must attempt to take the air. Prague will be occupied at 6.30 a.m.

A later message stated that German forces entered Prague at 9.20 a.m. Greenwich Mean Time.

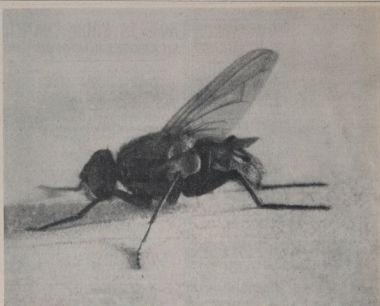

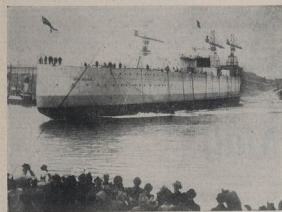

BRITISH PREPAREDNESS IN THE EVENT OF WAR

Oversea Force Could Embark At Short Notice: Debate In Parliament

Revised March 15. (Special Official Version.) (Special March 15, p. 2.)

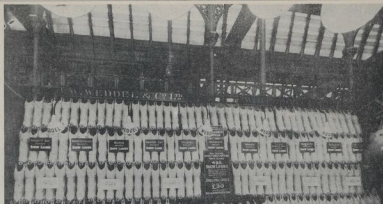
