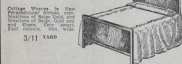

"WE SHALL NOT SLEEP"
Germany's impudent ultimatum to Lithuania, that latter country has refused to accept it.

In the first place, it is undoubtedly intended as a gesture of irritation of the other European Powers. After the return by the Lithuanians of the ultimatum to the United States, the former the Czechoslovak, British, French, the United States, the Netherlands, and other countries expressed their disapproval of the same ultimatum. They are, therefore, further indicated by preliminary measures taken by the Government of Lithuania.

The German ultimatum represents Her Hitler's mapping of the figures to show that it is a blatant challenge intended to expose the impotence of the League, and is possibly directed as much against internal reaction to the displacement of the Powers, as it is against the League.

The Poles realize that on this occasion he is facing a new united opposition that at any time in recent years. The German people themselves are probably not so ignorant as they are made to appear. They are, and undoubtedly it will, as it was intended, to impress the people of the world with the power and irresistible strength of their Führer.

Thus, by a single stroke, he has delivered his answer to the democracy, and it is again the League that has been the possibly falling mortar of Germany. The implications from the League are, therefore, very serious.

Turning from the psychological to the geographical, the impact of the ultimatum is obviously intended to put to the test the Baltic and east of communications of the Baltic Sea, and, like the Sudetenland, puts the pressure on the neutral territory. Request Awaited From The Two Controlling Bodies: Price Guarantee

The Government has agreed to purchase all fruit produced by taking over all the fruit produced at a guaranteed price, on condition that the New Zealand Fruitgrowers Federation and the Export Control Board as representatives of the whole industry give their consent to the Government.

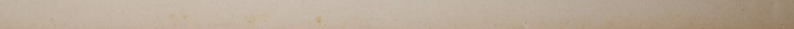

STORE CATTLE MARKET RE-OPENS

Stortford Lodge Sale FAT STOCK PRICES REMAIN FIRM New Auction For Store Sheep

There was a short yarding of fat cattle at Stortford Lodge yesterday, with prices a little lower for the better quality beef, but medium and poorly finished ones were not wanted at any price.

The yarding consisted of about 160 head, about 60 of these being cutters. Quality was fairly well mixed, with the top two extremes outstanding. The penings were either well-finished or else they were extremely poor quality.

On beef was again in short supply and is hardly worth quoting. The value market was also a small one, but there was a great deal of quality to choose from. Prices were firm for a poor selection, but were no real criterion of the market.

The short offering of store cattle for some time came before the buyers and the prices ruling were rather above average.

The yarding consisted of over 400, the main offering coming from Waiwaka, and the whole of the yarding was disposed of under the hammer.

The majority of the yarding were young cattle ranging from 16 months to 30 months. The lots showed breeding and coming in the high country, mostly developed well on the heavier food pastures.

The store sheep market was extremely good and a draughting sale was performed, showing a drop of 5 per cent to 10 per cent. The demand was very much on the wane, with buyers making the better of the market on the sheep's side.

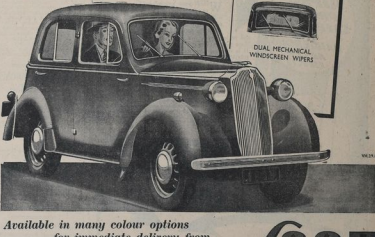
