GERMAN REJECTION OF BECK'S CLAIM IN ADDRESS TO DIET ANGLO-POLISH TREATY A THREAT TO REICH?: CASE OF DANZIG OFFICIAL VIEW CONVEYED TO DOMINION

By Telegraph—Press Association. WELLINGTON, May 8. The following comment on Colonel Beck's speech to the Polish Diet on Poland's foreign policy, taken from the "Vostokher Botshetnik," the official organ of the National Socialist German Labour Party, has been received by the German Consul-General at Wellington (H. V. Ramm):

"The speech of Colonel Beck disappointed because it does not give the reasons for the rejection of the Polish Diet's proposal. The main reason which obliged the German Reich to refuse the proposal of 1938 as framed was not the Polish attempt to annex the German provinces, but the complete lack of any basis for the proposed Anglo-Polish treaty of friendship."

"With alterations this treaty plan is obliged to be rejected because the Reich is unable to provide the security which the Polish Government demands in the matter for which reason. It is impossible to reconcile this demand for a treaty of friendship with the recent decision of the pact of 1934, by which the use of arms between Germany and Poland was mutually prohibited."

"It is incorrect when Colonel Beck made his declaration in his last speech to the Reichstag on May 7, 1939, that the Reich was not in a position to make any concessions in the matter of the Danzig question. 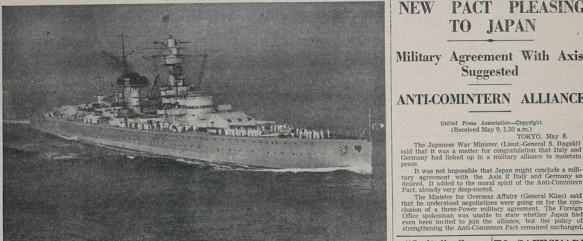

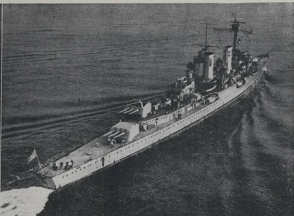
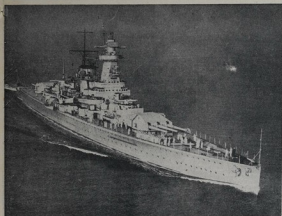

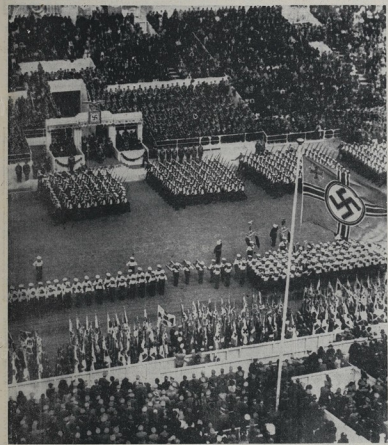

The error of the International Jockeys Union on Saturday in allowing only one-half of the place pool to be divided for the runners for start in the Short Hurdles is attributable, A. A., as the usual Government award was presented to the return and dividend, the mistake is still borne to understand.

According to the Rules of Racing the place pool must be divided equally between the placed horses, and that rule is printed in the official race book, the wording being quite easy to follow. It states—

"The amount of the place pool available for divided cup-riding should be divided into as many parts as there are horses in the division, and the amount of each part should be divided equally among the number of such horses as may exceed the number of such places."

The first part of the rule explains the whole matter, but the reference to dead-beats increasing the number of places explains the fact that the place pool must be divided equally between the placed horses.

Very often, the division of the pool is made at Hawera, usually the fastest runner. After all, the dead-beats were only half their worth and received only 1/2 each of the £10 allotted the third horse. To be consistent in taking the amount of the first two placed horses, a portion of their prize money should also be allotted the dead-beats for a third.

However, rules are rules, and until this rule is altered, what obtained elsewhere should now be adhered to at Hawera. There will be a ray over the brackets for tomorrow, but that fact remains that nothing can now be done for the supporters of Lulu Rose and Devon Star who were unpaid.
