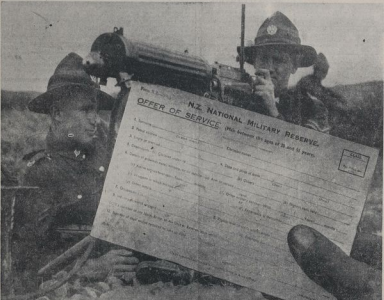

### PRIME QUALITY SHEEP GO AT CHEAP RATES

#### Stortford Lodge Yesterday

A large yarding of fat cattle, shepher for the most part fat quality, met a weak market at the Stortford Lodge stock sale yesterday. The yarding was broken up by the best prime quality line offered, and at the beginning of the sale prices were low, and buyers preferring not to accept the low prices offered.

There were buyers in a comparatively fat hided and cows, and towards the end of the offering selling draught, but competition was inferior and poorer sorts were hard to dispose of.

Stock yards showed no improvement on recent rates. Demand was not high, although in this section, too, some fat quality animals were offered.

The vendors were for the most part prepared to meet the ruling rates.

Asah in the store sheep section was little demanded for the reason that the price for fat stock was at a low level, but poorer prices were not wanted.

A further decline in price for sheep was also apparent. Good lines of ewes attracted little attention, and it failed to raise their price. The poorer quality did not bring particularly good prices, and though most vendors were prepared to meet the market, selling was not easy.

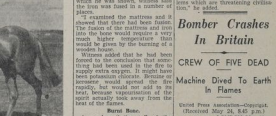
