The Japanese Foreign Office spokesman said today that in the event of British retaliation over the Tientsin blockade the Japanese attitude would be stiffened, thereby increasing the gravity of the situation.

The naval spokesman said that the navy was not yet involved, as it was readily should the necessity arise.

The Statistical correspondent of "The Times" says that the Japanese authorities at Tientsin have rejected the British proposal for a committee of inquiry into the murder of Chang Shih-kang without referring it to Tokyo. They informed the British authorities that while they appreciated the spirit in which the proposal was made, it came too late for them to alter their plans at such short notice.

They added that if the late Chinese agent had been arrested the matter would have been easier, they now propose to continue the blockade until the British Government "changes its attitude completely."

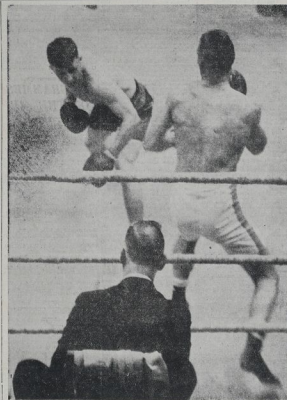

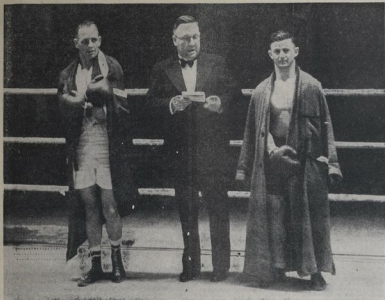

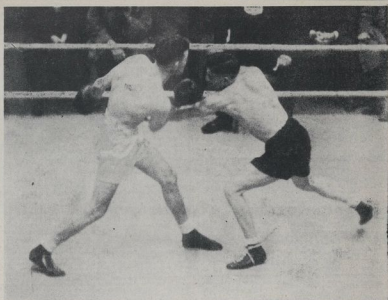
