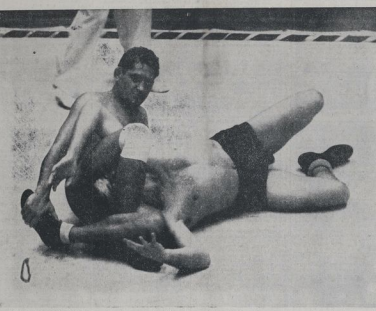

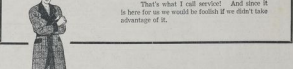

### INTERESTING TRAINING.

Territorial training consists of week-end camps, annual camps, out-of-camp training, and courses of instruction. Annual camps and courses are normally of six days; most units do four week-end camps and in addition a number of evening parties.

**Week-end Camps.**—These are held during the summer months in selected out-of-town localities. Free transport is provided and instruction in interesting work in the field is carried out.

**Camp.**—Camp is the climax of the Territorial's year, and it is here that initiative and enthusiasm become so apparent. Those who have experienced it are all unanimous that nothing equals a Territorial Camp. Who can resist the thrill when the troops come surging down the road — flash their messages across the skies, or build bridges, or bring the guns into action. There, sports, dance, concerts, good food and plenty of it, and pay for rank for territory.

**Out-of-Camp Training.**—This consists of instruction for the annual mastery course — always held far away from the home town. Many units are held during the year, which are entirely paid for. Many units provide supper after voluntary evening parties and have arranged recreational facilities and provision for games and physical training, and other social activities such as dances and concerts.

### UNIFORMS.

All Non-commissioned Officers and men of the Territorial Force are to be issued with a smart blue uniform for walking out and full dress occasions. In addition each Territorial is issued with service dress, including pair of boots, renewable every three years, and a gaiter. Working kit in the shape of khaki dungie are provided for camps, etc., and khaki shorts are issued wherever they represent the most comfortable form of dress. Motor transport drivers have a special working uniform of khaki overalls and the free and off cap. Motor cyclists, in addition to the above, are provided free with leather knee boots, gaiterless gloves and a levet other black or khaki.

### PAY AND ALLOWANCES.

No true volunteer joins the Army because of the money he will get out of it, but on the other hand, no volunteer Territorial should be out of pocket by undertaking this public duty. Twelve shillings a day for normal camps and for courses of instruction. The amount is made up of 7/- in normal camp and for allowances. That makes the New Zealand troops get the highest pay volunteer in the world. Expenses are provided for the motor for camps and courses, plus pay for the day travelling to and from camp. Regimental Funds to the value of £5. per soldier are provided to the unit for social and other expense. Rates are paid from all parades (over a reasonable walking distance) except when paid to all territorial! The financial conditions are excellent.

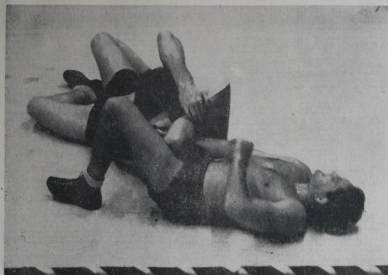

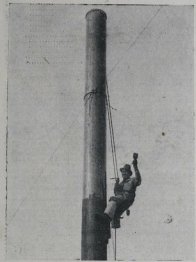

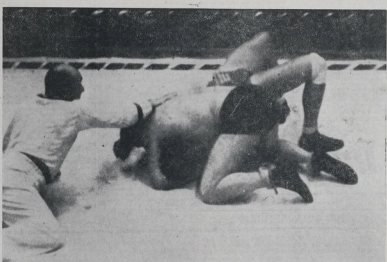

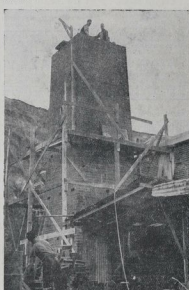

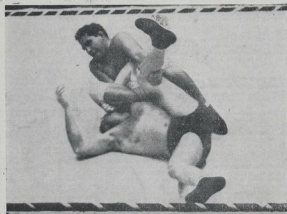
