BRITAIN AND JAPAN BOTH STAND FIRM ON CLAIMS TO TIENSIN

DEADLOCK SEEMS INEVITABLE IN TOKYO NEGOTIATIONS

**THE WEST CANNOT BECOME ACCOMPLICES
OF EASTERN MILITARISTS**

LONDON, July 16—British official circles in Tokyo denied today that the Tientsin talks were forced to conclude, although there is not much optimism of success, since both parties are unprepared to give ground.

The Japanese are reported to be claiming that Tientsin is not British but Chinese and that the British have usurped Chinese sovereignty.

A message from Tokyo states that the talks have been suspended until Wednesday, when British Ambassador (Sir Robert Gaitanaris) has received no instructions from London.

"The Times" in an editorial says: "There is little hope of a success, but it is difficult to Japan view as claiming British rights without acquiescing."

The Japanese demand for such a concession cannot be regarded as the recognition of this country will stand by its refusal to become the passive accomplice of the Japanese militarists.

If the negotiations fail and are followed by British troops by default Chinese forces, there will be no point in keeping British officials in danger in Tientsin. It is, therefore, no reason to give the Chinese Republic the full benefit of the Tientsin talks.

The Tokyo correspondence of "The Times" writes that anti-British propaganda in the city had been going on for some time. British Embassy gaitanaris were also seen on the streets of Tientsin, but the Japanese are not dealing with the initiation of the Tientsin talks.

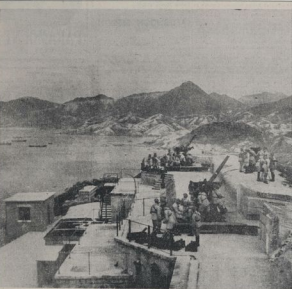

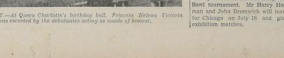

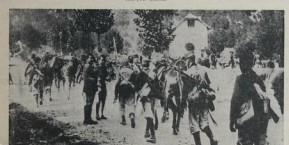

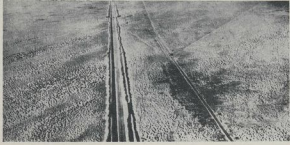
