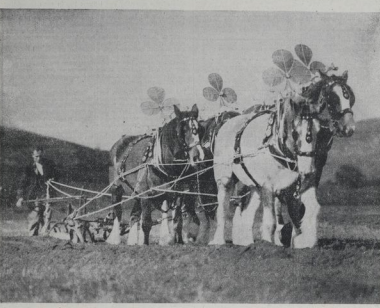

Long and Severe Tests For Young Girls 5000 APPLY FOR 29 VACANCIES

Why do girls want to be police-women? For the first time in the young New York City is reviewing women candidates for the police force, and taking its pick of thousands of girls who want the job. Paul Kern, president of the Municipal Civil Service Commission, says that they represent "the best group of young women we've ever had on any examination."

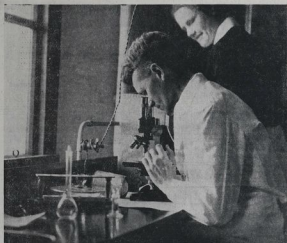

THE HOUSE OF THE HILL.—A view of the main receiving block at the Napier Hospital. A familiar sight to many who have been waiting for the initial treatment received.



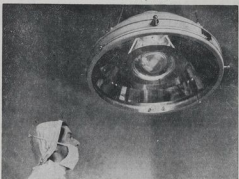

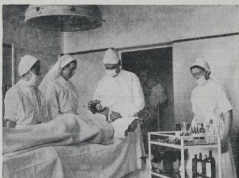

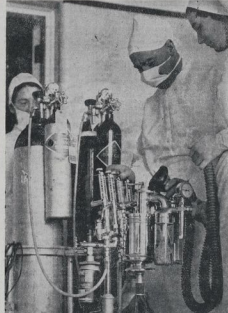

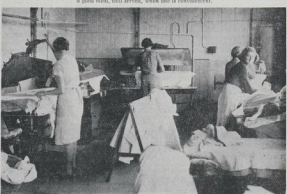
