IN view of the continued trouble on the Manchukuo border, the Japanese Government has announced the immediate suspension of the provisions of the National Defense Law. That is, that a virtual state of war has been proclaimed in Manchukuo, which is most concerned over the clashes with the Soviet-Mongol troops.

The Premier of Manchukuo has further declared that troops shall be sent to the border, and that the Japanese will bombard Soviet positions on the west bank of the Khalkin Golo.

London dispatch cables say that an Army communication states that 20 Soviet planes were brought down on the Manchukuo frontier on July 25. The Japanese air force heavily bombarded Soviet positions on the west bank of the Khalkin Golo.

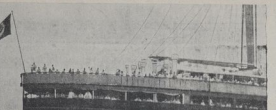
