## French Drive Reaches Saarbrucken

CITIES BEING EVACUATED

Allied Tanks And Planes Assist In Seven-Mile Advance

MUNITIONS PLANTS BOMBED

PARIS, Sept. 6.

A communique to-day announced that the French forces are progressing beyond the German frontier.  
Other French sources state that they have penetrated the Saar Basin. Simultaneously, French tanks and planes supporting the front troops had laid fortified munition plants north of the Saar. It is reported that Strasbourg and other cities such as Metz have been evacuated.

A later Polish report states that the French are at Saarbrucken.  
Some reports have been given by London by experts to this report, as a deep salient of the offensive proceeds into the Reich. This salient is regarded as one of the weak links of the German frontiers.

Another report from London in the evening reported heavy firing at Luxembourg, Saarbrucken, and other points south of Luxemburg.

A later French communique says that at 5.45 a.m. on September 7, the German forces were in Metz.

According to Luxembourg reports, the maximum French advance towards Saarbrucken was a distance of 25 miles. It is reported that the French used 500 tanks in one day.

It is also stated that, in an advance 125 miles further north, 300 Allied planes attacked a German position. Allied forces in large numbers also attacked the great steel and munition region in the area.

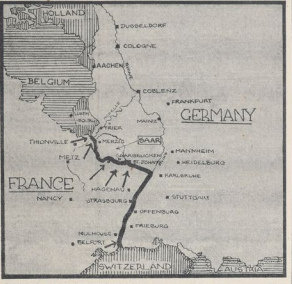

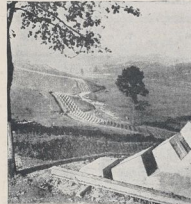

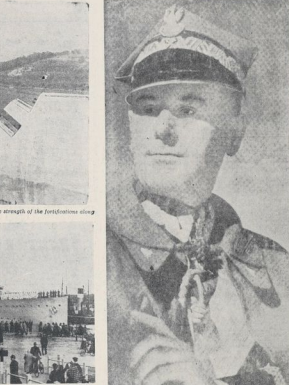

By now something of the strategy of the Allied force is becoming apparent. While Poland is fighting a desperate rearguard action to stem the Nazi invaders, France is pressing back on Germany's northern and southern flanks on the Franco-German frontier. The object is to give her Western Allies time to press Germany on the eastern front, and if Poland's main forces can be preserved until the Nazis are compelled to divert their attention to the west, Poland will have a position to bargain in.

While it is not anticipated that there will be any quick success in this conflict, it is particularly true that the fact that during the first few days twenty-five years ago that we are beginning with the advantages in our favour.
