ALLIES SMASH ACROSS FRONTIER INTO THE SAAR A Double Thrust into Germany

FLANK ATTACK BEGUN ON SIEGFRIED LINE Great Air Force Activity

United Press Association—Copyright. (Received Sept. 11, 2 p.m.) The British United Press correspondent says it can now be revealed that the French High Command has decided to double thrust during the first operations of the war. They struck at a point near the junction of the French, German and Swiss frontiers, near Belfort, striking straight into Germany through the Saar.

If Nounkuchen falls, the capture of Saarbrücken is now reported to be in process. Its encirclement would open the way to the valley of the Rhine via Homburg and Kaiserlautern.

A British division participated in the main attack, consisting in the capture of important positions.

A late Paris communique states that German counter-attacks at numerous points were broken during the night. The situation is unchanged. Air activity is normal.

Before the outbreak of the war it was predicted for the French to obtain a clear victory of the Siegfried Line, since the war French forces have been continuously flying over the line, photographing it from all angles. These have now been joined together to form a detailed plan of the German defenses.

It is believed that the Associated Press in London has obtained that French tanks and infantry are reported to have crossed the frontier, on the left, in a tanking attack against the Siegfried line.
