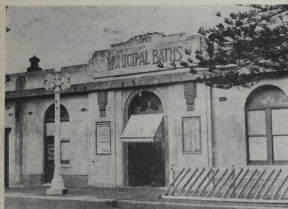

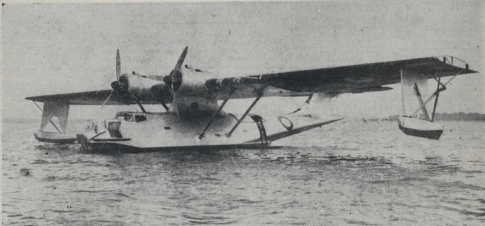

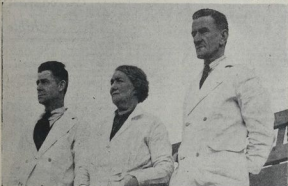
A MODERN BUILDING—A general view of the modern facade of the Napier Municipal Baths.
