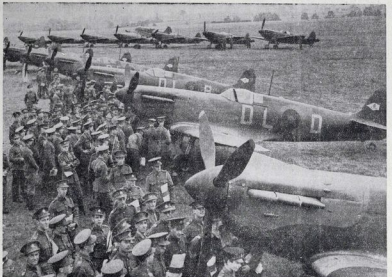

A Sensational Arrest In Poland FRIEND OF DR. GOEBBELS Plotting By German Minority Revealed MARTIAL LAW LIKELY

LONDON, Aug. 17. A Warsaw message says that Rudolf Wisner, leader of the Young German Party in Upper Silesia, and 60 members have been arrested on charges of espionage. The arrest of Wisner, who is one of the two principal leaders of the German minority in Poland, an intimate friend of Dr. P. J. Goebbels, and often called Slisko's Hebble, presages a sweeping Polish campaign to stamp out trouble-makers.

Wisner's arrest has created a sensation and is accepted as proof that Poland will not repeat Czechoslovakia's success over Sudetenland. Yesterday's arrests are reported to be the result of the discovery of a widespread plot centred in German Silesia to undermine Polish authority. The arrests are said to total hundreds, including Janowski, leader of the Young German Youth and the Workers' Guild Two of the most prominent minority organizations.
